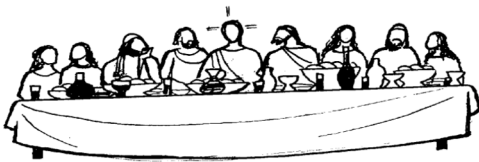
Holy Thursday “Foot Washing”

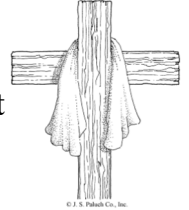

Good Friday Regulations

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Good Friday.

Fasting is observed on Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18-years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one’s needs but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

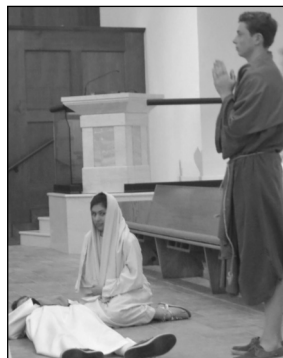

Not all predators fit a mold

Many people mistakenly believe that all predators fit into a mold, and that by teaching children to avoid those kinds of people, they will be safe. Another common belief is that an abuser or predator would most likely be a stranger, or a mean and scary person. Not all situations follow this pattern. Parents should focus on teaching their children how to handle uncomfortable situations, by getting away immediately and going to a trusted adult. Parents should also keep watch for signs of abuse or distress in their children. 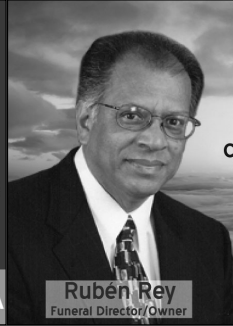
