

The Sacred Heart of Jesus

June is the month dedicated to The Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Practice of honoring the Heart of Jesus is an old one stemming from a devotion to Christ's Sacred Humanity. The Blessed Mother, the apostles, and the fathers of the Church revered especially the wound which exposed His Heart fostered this devotion. In October 1672, inspired by St. John Eudes a solemn liturgical celebration was begun. The devotion was given greater impetus by the appearances (between 1673 & 1675) of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. The well-known Promises of Our Lord were made at this time. Jesus wants this devotion to be distinguished by its emphasis on His merciful and understanding LOVE. And, in turn, He asks EXTRA love of us in the name of those who show coldness, neglect, and indifference to His Love. How do you do this? Start off the day with the Morning Offering prayer. Receive the Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist as often as possible. The practice of the Nine First Fridays is a good way to participate in this outstanding gift of Our Savior Himself. "Let it (devotion to the Sacred Heart) be esteemed by all", wrote Pope Paul VI, "as an excellent form of true piety, which in our times, especially, because of the norms laid down in the Second Vatican Council, must be rendered to Christ Jesus, the King and the Center of all hearts, Who is Head of His Body, The Church."

The Morning Offering Prayer:

O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer you my prayers, works, joys and sufferings of this day in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world. I offer them for all the intentions of your Sacred Heart: the salvation of souls, the reparation for sin, and the reunion of all Christians. I offer them for the intentions of our bishops and of all Apostles of Prayer, and in particular for those recommended by our Holy Father this month.


The Twelve Promises to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque for those Devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus:

1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
2. I will establish peace in their families.
3. I will console them in all their troubles.
4. They shall find in My Heart an assured refuge during life and especially at the hour of their death.
5. I will pour abundant blessings on all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source of an infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Lukewarm souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection.
9. I will bless the homes where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored.
10. I will give to devotees of My Heart the power of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced.
12. The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under my displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments; My Heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.


Summer Choir will Start June 26th
