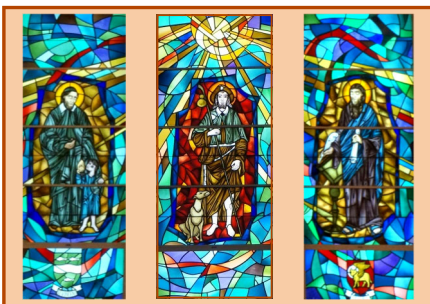

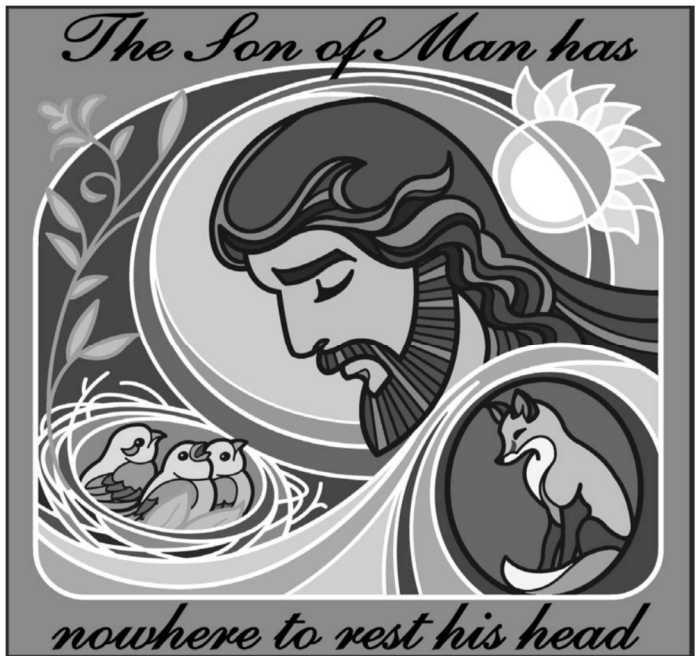

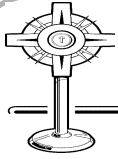
The San Roque Food Drive is sponsored by the San Roque Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul for our local Catholic Charities Food Pantry.

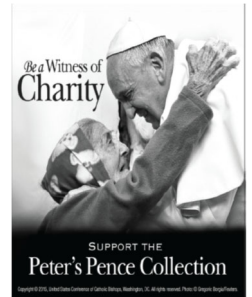
The Blessed Sacrament

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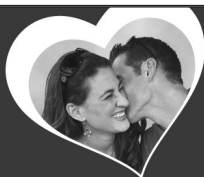
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
