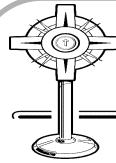

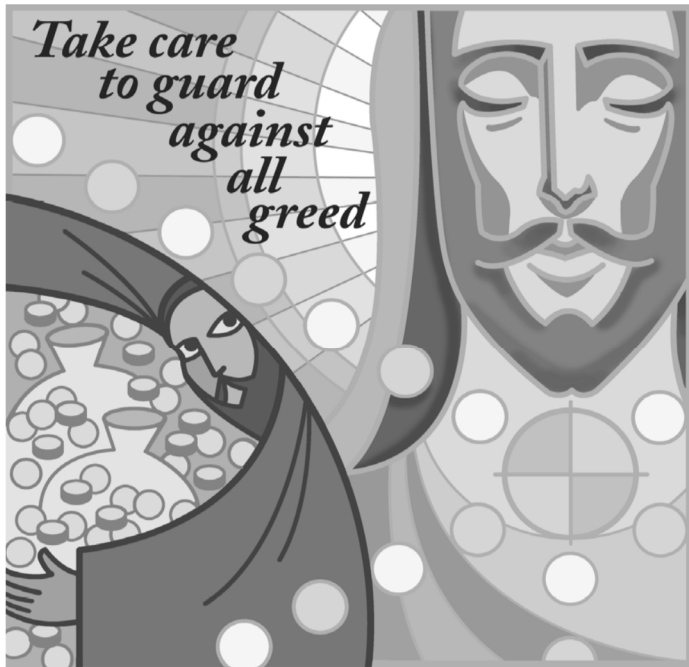

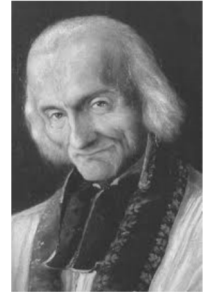

### *SAINTS*

Saint John Vianney  
1786 - 1859  
Feast Day: August 4



Jean-Baptiste-Marie Vianney was born May 8, 1786 in Dardilly, France. He was the fourth of six children. He was raised in a Catholic home and the family often helped the poor. During the anticlerical phase of the French Revolution, priests were being martyred and young Jean believed the priests were heroes.

At age 13 John made his first communion and prepared for his confirmation in secrecy due to the Revolution. On August 12, 1815 he joined his heroes and was ordained a priest. When he began his priestly duties, Fr. Vianney realized many were either ignorant or indifferent to religion as a result of the Revolution. He spent much time in confession and preached passionately about the Lord. People came from miles around to have him hear their confession. In 1853 he died known by many as the Cure of Ars, left a legacy of faith and was viewed as a champion of the poor. In 1925 he was canonized a saint and his body is known to be incorrupt.

Saint John Vianney would often say, "Private prayer is like straw scattered here and there: If you set it on fire, it makes a lot of little flames. But gather these straws into a bundle and light them, and you get a mighty fire, rising like a column into the sky; public prayer is like that."

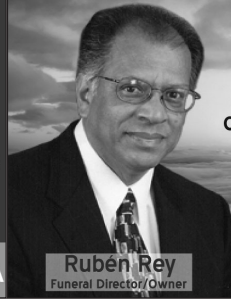
