

Missionary Cooperative Plan

Next weekend, Rev. Joseph K. Santiago, from the Diocese of Thanjavur, India, and a resident at St. Catherine Laboure in Torrence, CA, will speak at all our Masses.

The Diocese of Thanjavur is located on the east coast of South India. It covers an area of 3,687 square miles with a population of 7 million people, of whom only 250,000 are Catholics, and the rest are Hindus and Muslims. Being rural and agricultural, the Diocese has a great financial burden in maintaining parishes and continuing the work of evangelization. Flood and drought are common to the people. At present, the Diocese manages numerous schools, boarding homes (orphanages) for children who have lost one or both of their parents, nursing homes, homes for the destitute, and a home for the mentally disabled run by the sisters of Blessed Mother Theresa of Kolkata.

The Diocese is proclaiming God's Good News of His kingdom to the poor, agricultural laborers, and fishing communities. Missionary works include Catechetical training, Formation to lay Catholics from Villages and mission stations, regarding the church, bible, Sacraments and prayers. On receiving training, they go back to their communities and teach. People are poor and are not able to contribute to the church. The Diocese of Thanjavur runs 53 orphanages, the highest in all the dioceses of India. Orphans and semi orphan children of all religions, numbering about 2,500 are living in the orphanages. They are fed, clothed and educated, all for free. More so, orphans were added in the aftermath of Tsunami in 2004 in which many lost their families.

Missionary Cooperative Plan funds are also used to train priests, seminarians and to build chapels. The Diocese receives a good number of vocations to the priesthood and religious life and needs financial support for their training and formation. The Diocese also cares for widows and the physically disabled, provides shelter and dairy animals for the poor, and continues to care for the victims of the Tsunami.

Given the situation in the Diocese of Thanjavur, they are in desperate need of financial support. Please be generous and support the Missionary Cooperative Plan. Please keep the Catholics of Thanjavur in your prayers. This is a unique opportunity for you to be a missionary and to reach out to India by way of your prayers and financial support. Saints

Saint John Vianney

1786 - 1859

Feast Day: August 4



Jean-Baptiste-Marie Vianney was born

May 8, 1786 in Dardilly, France. He was the fourth of six children. He was raised in a Catholic home and the family often helped the poor. During the anticlerical phase of the French Revolution, priests were being martyred and young Jean believed the priests were heroes.

At age 13 John made his first communion and prepared for his confirmation in secrecy due to the Revolution. On August 12, 1815 he joined his heroes and was ordained a priest. When he began his priestly duties, Fr. Vianney realized many were either ignorant or indifferent to religion as a result of the Revolution. He spent much time in confession and preached passionately about the Lord. People came from miles around to have him hear their confession. In 1853 he died known by many as the Cure of Ars, left a legacy of faith and was viewed as a champion of the poor. In 1925 he was canonized a saint and his body is known to be incorrupt.

Saint John Vianney would often say, "Private prayer is like straw scattered here and there: If you set it on fire, it makes a lot of little flames. But gather these straws into a bundle and light them, and you get a mighty fire, rising like a column into the sky; public prayer is like that."
