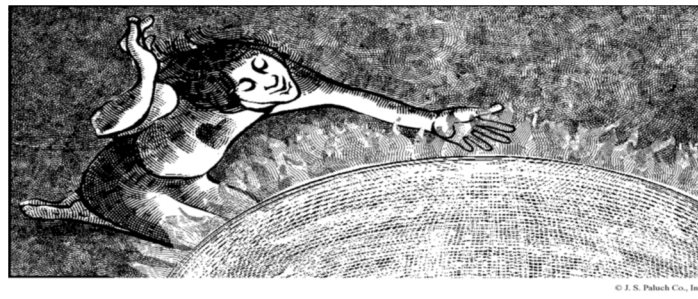

## What is R.C.I.A. and how do I know if I would benefit from attending?



Maybe you attend Mass with a Catholic friend or spouse and have become interested in finding out more about the Catholic faith. Perhaps you are Catholic but a book, movie, person or event has challenged your faith. Maybe your children are asking questions that you cannot answer about your own faith. In these cases, R.C.I.A. may be what you need.

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (R.C.I.A.) is an eight-month process for those who would like to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church from other faiths, and for those seeking to better understand the Catholic faith. This is what one of our participants wrote about her experience: ***“I knew I wanted to become a Catholic but I wasn’t sure when! I decided to take the RCIA class without any plan in mind and was overwhelmed with emotion and thanksgiving. The first class was all I needed to know the time was now!”***

R.C.I.A. is for you if you have a desire to grow spiritually, to mature in your faith, and would like to receive any of the following sacraments as an adult: baptism, communion, and/or confirmation. We meet every Monday evening from 6 to 8 PM in the Choir Loft. **Our first meeting will be held Monday, September 19th.** There is no charge to attend and no materials to be purchased. Materials will be given to every participant on the first day of class.
