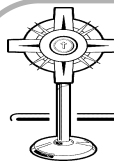

What is R.C.I.A. and how do I know if I would benefit from attending?

Maybe you attend Mass with a friend or spouse and have become interested in finding out more about the Catholic faith. Perhaps you are Catholic but a book, movie, person or event has challenged your faith. Maybe your children are asking questions that you cannot answer about your own faith. In these cases, R.C.I.A. may be what you need.

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (R.C.I.A.) is an eight-month process for those who would like to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church from other faiths, and for those seeking to better understand the Catholic faith. This is what one of our participants wrote about her experience: ***“I knew I wanted to become a Catholic but I wasn’t sure when! I decided to take the RCIA class without any plan in mind and was overwhelmed with emotion and thanksgiving. The first class was all I needed to know the time was now!”***

R.C.I.A. is for you if you have a desire to grow spiritually, to mature in your faith, and would like to receive any of the following sacraments as an adult: baptism, communion, and/or confirmation. We meet every Monday evening from 6 to 8 PM in the Choir Loft. There is no charge to attend and no materials to be purchased. Materials will be given to every participant of the class.

ST. ANTHONY'S SERMON TO THE FISHES

Many of us pray to St. Anthony to help us find lost articles, but we do not know what a great preacher he was!

One day Anthony was preaching to the heretics in Rimini who refused to listen to his teaching about God. So he decided to preach to the fish in the sea. He said, "Listen to the word of God, O ye fishes of the sea and river, seeing that the faithless heretics refuse to do so." Suddenly, a great multitude of fish gathered before him with their heads above the water.

He continued, "My brother fishes, you are bound to return thanks to your Creator, who has given you so noble an element for your dwelling; for you have at your choice both sweet water and salt; you have many places of refuge from the tempest; you have likewise a pure and transparent element for nourishment. God, your bountiful and kind Creator, when he made you ordered you to increase and multiply, and gave you his blessing. In the universal deluge all other creatures perished, you alone did God preserve from harm. He has given you fins to enable you to go where you will. (continued above)

To you it was granted, to keep the prophet Jonas, and after three days to throw him safe and sound on dry land. You it was who gave the tribute money to our Savior Jesus Christ, when through his poverty, he had not where-with to pay. By a singular mystery you were the nourishment of the eternal King, Jesus Christ, both before and after his resurrection. Because of all these things you are bound to praise and bless the Lord, who has given you blessings so many and so much greater than to other creatures."

At these words, the fish began to open their mouths, and bow their heads and jump in the water. Seeing this reaction Anthony said, "Blessed be the eternal God, for the fishes of the sea honor him more than men without faith, and animals without reason listen to his word with greater attention than the heretics." Because of this miracle, the heretics were amazed, listened to Anthony preach the word of God and all were converted.
