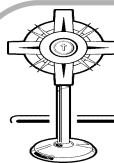

What is R.C.I.A. and how do I know if I would benefit from attending?

Maybe you attend Mass with a friend or spouse and have become interested in finding out more about the Catholic faith. Perhaps you are Catholic but a book, movie, person or event has challenged your faith. Maybe your children are asking questions that you cannot answer about your own faith. In these cases, R.C.I.A. may be what you need.

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (R.C.I.A.) is an eight-month process for those who would like to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church from other faiths, and for those seeking to better understand the Catholic faith. This is what one of our participants wrote about her experience: *"I knew I wanted to become a Catholic but I wasn't sure when! I decided to take the RCIA class without any plan in mind and was overwhelmed with emotion and thanksgiving. The first class was all I needed to know the time was now!"*

R.C.I.A. is for you if you have a desire to grow spiritually, to mature in your faith, and would like to receive any of the following sacraments as an adult: baptism, communion, and/or confirmation. We meet every Monday evening from 6 to 8 PM in the Choir Loft. There is no charge to attend and no materials to be purchased. Materials will be given to every participant of the class.

Saint Theresa of Avila
1515-1582
Feast Day: October 15



Teresa Sanchez de Ceoeda y Ahumada was born in Avila, Spain. Her father was a Jewish convert to Christianity. She was fascinated by the lives of the saints as a child. At the age of 14 her mother died, causing Teresa much grief. Through this she grew closer to the Virgin Mary, but also developed some bad habits and was sent to live in a convent for her education. Her prayer life grew immensely, and she began to experience deep prayer and “devotions of ecstasy”. Eventually she wrote a book on prayer called “The Interior Castle” which is read by many today. She was canonized in 1622 by Pope Gregory XV.

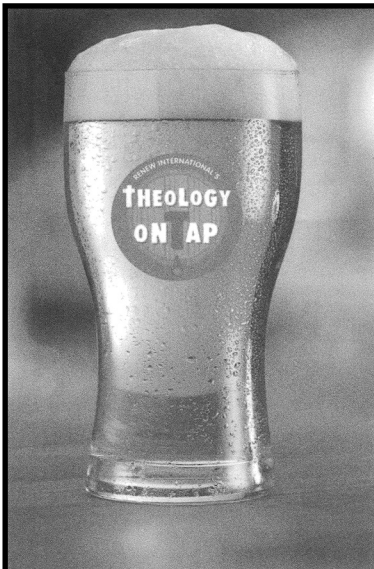
