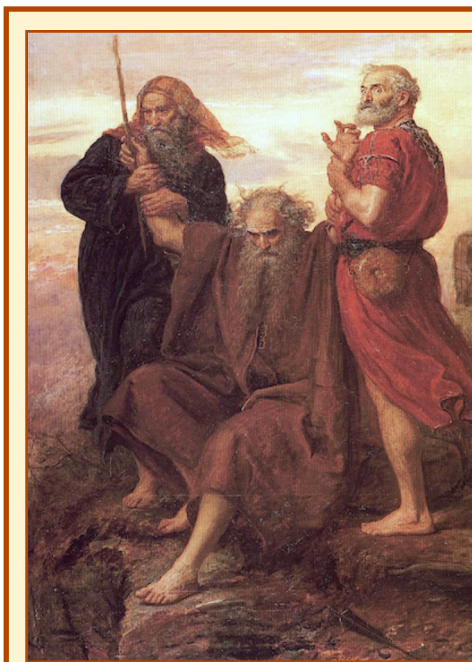

SAN ROQUE PARISH FINANCIAL REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 15/16

(Period from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016)

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Thanks to your generosity our parish has fared well financially in recent times. This year, however, we have cause for concern. Inflationary expenses have risen this year and are not being offset by Offertory income. The result is that we have become increasingly dependent on school rental subsidy to meet day-to-day operation needs. We are fortunate to have this supplementary rent income. We need to use it wisely.

Offertory income alone should be adequate to sustain our day-to-day financial needs. However, we have 380 families who have parish donation envelopes. We average approximately 160 envelopes per Sunday. Many people also give generously without the use of envelopes.

Using parish envelopes helps us plan more efficiently as it is a predictable amount. Also, envelope users usually ensure their donations are made even when out-of-town or not in attendance on a particular Sunday.

If you have not done so in the past year, I would ask that everyone prayerfully consider increasing your weekly contribution to put us on a more stable financial path. I realize that you make other charitable contributions and appreciate your generosity to our parish.

Charity continues as an important mission of our parish. This year's Together-in-Mission donation set a new record. Our assigned goal was exceeded by over \$10,000. Over-goal amounts are returned to our parish and used to help local charities in need.

We completed several important Growth & Development improvements this last year. They include new lighting for the church parking area, new low water maintenance landscaping, and improved sound systems.

This year marks a milestone in our school lease relationship. The last five years, El Montecito School (ELMO) sublet our school property from San Roque School, the primary lease holder. On July 15th, the lease was officially transferred to El Montecito School. They have been a good tenant and we are pleased with this development.

As always, I pray for God's blessing on you, your loved ones and the many faithful parishioners who have passed away.

Avoid ‘fixing’ and try to listen and understand

For some problems, children only need a good listener; for others they need guidance and help discerning how best to respond. 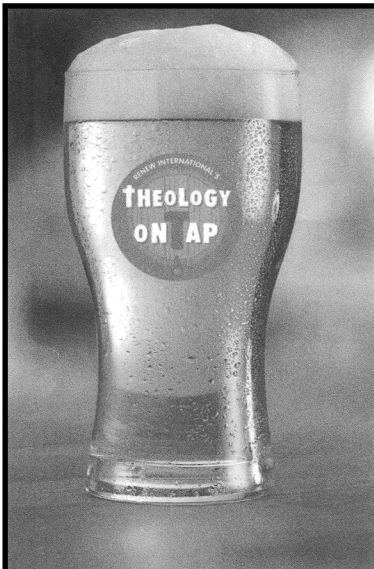
