SAINTS

Saint Elizabeth of Hungary
1207-1231
Feast Day: November 17

Elizabeth was the daughter of King Alexander II of Hungary. She was a princess and a very pious child. She married Prince Louis at an early age, who was also quite religious, and had three children.



After her husband's death fighting in the Crusades, Elizabeth rejected the world and became a tertiary of St. Francis. She lived in a castle, but lived an austere and simple life practicing penance and devoting herself to charity.

She eventually built a Franciscan hospital near her castle and fed the poor and sick daily. When others tried to keep her from going to help the poor, she would say, "I want to be able to say to Jesus, when you were hungry I gave you to eat; when you had nothing to put on, I clothed you; when you were sick, I visited you, because you said that in doing these things for the poor, I did them for you."

One story says that she even brought a leper into her home to care for him. She devoted herself to the care of the sick until her death at the young age of 24. Very soon after her death, miracles of healing were reported at the hospital. She was canonized by Pope Gregory IX a few years after the miracles were found to be authentic.
