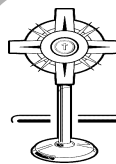

One mobile app, Kik, is regarded as the most dangerous site for internet predators, because users can send messages to anyone with a cellphone, including your children. Kik has no options for parental controls, leaving kids exposed to the entire web. Sister of Providence

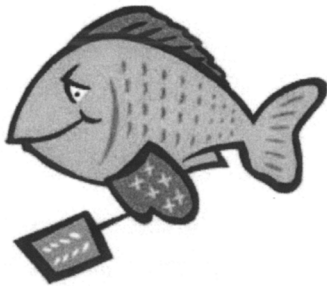
