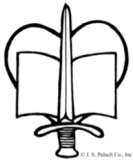

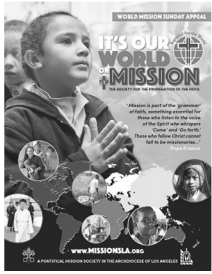
Held every Thursday evening at 6:00 p.m. the Rosary is said along with prayers for spiritual, mental & physical healing.

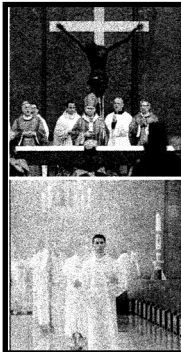
