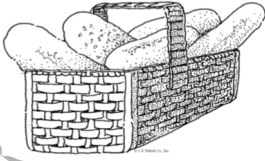

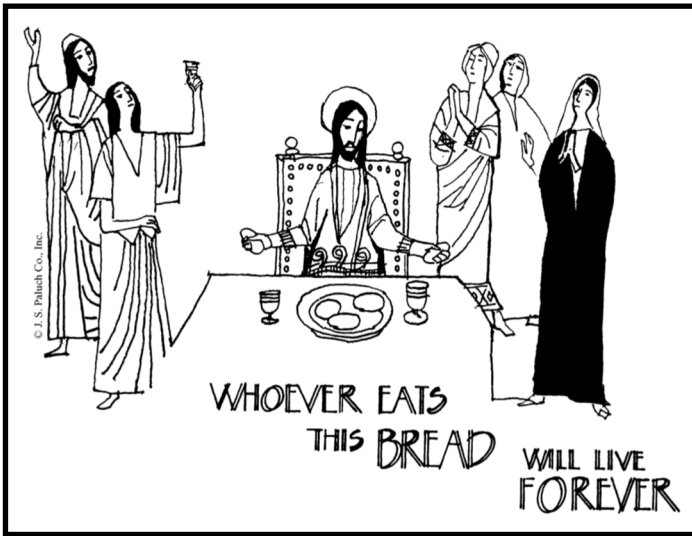

## Missionary Cooperative Plan

This weekend, Father Patrick “Pat” Travers, ss.cc., a representative of the **Tijuana Mission Outreach Foundation** will speak at all our Masses. The **Tijuana Mission Outreach Foundation** was founded by Father Pat in the 1980’s at Damien High School, La Verne, CA. It started out as a service commitment for the students. They would make one-day trips, on Saturdays, to San Eugenio, La Morita, Tijuana and do “grunt” jobs. Then there were opportunities to bring food. This built up to one major food event which was named the Epiphany and five other small food drives in a year. For the Epiphany a large number of people, 50-100, would travel down on a Sunday in January and hand out 10 lbs. each of rice, beans and flour, three loaves of bread, a ham, toiletries, toilet tissue, soccer balls, and a large quantity of toys to over 200 needy families. The smaller food trips consisted of bringing rice, beans, flour, bread, toilet tissue and miscellaneous items to about 50 needy families. Along the way we started building houses. A group of fathers and sons would go to the La Morita area for one-week and build upwards of six houses. As of today they have built over 80 houses, 8 churches, 6 sets of classrooms and a community center. Their support has come from peoples’ generosity.

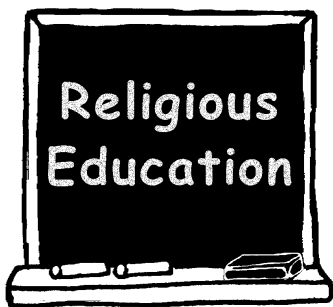

- ♦ **Did you know that** in 1773, Junípero Serra traveled to Mexico City and presented a list of grievances, *Representación*, to Viceroy Bucareli delineating 32 points of contention? His primary concerns dealt with “the most important topic,” soldier immorality and violation of Native American women and children whom Serra called “his children.” The favorable response of the Viceroy became known as “the first significant body of laws to govern early California.”

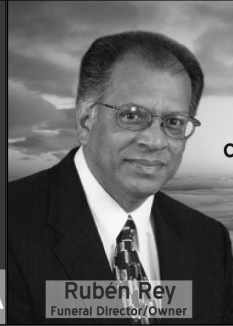

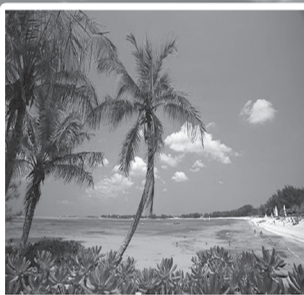

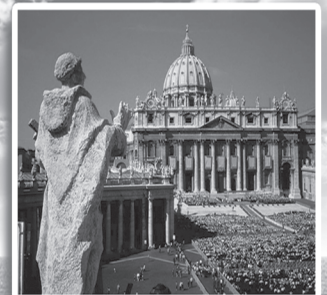
