## Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time August 16, 2015



St. Roch (pronounced Rock or in Spanish, *San Roque*) was born at Montpellier, France and nursed the sick during a plague in Italy. Roch not only cared for the sick, but cured large numbers of people.

Roch became infected in Piacenza and not wishing to be a burden on any hospital, dragged himself out into the woods to die. Here he was miraculously fed by a dog, whose master soon found Roch and looked after him. Upon recovery, he returned to Piacenza and miraculously cured many more people, as well as their sick animals.

At age 27, he returned home to Montpellier, where he was arrested as a spy and thrown into prison. He was unrecognized as the son of the former governor due to the ravages of his illness. It wasn't until he died five years later that they recognized him by a cross-shaped birthmark on his breast. Miraculous happenings and cures followed his death and today St. Roch is still invoked against diseases of all kinds. St. Roch is a patron saint against diseases, notably as a healer of contagion of all kinds. His feast day is on August 16.

The truth is we are blessed abundantly when we reach out to others. The volunteer members of the San Roque Conference of St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) try to answer the call to help the least of our brethren.

In teams of two, Vincentians visit, pray, listen and understand the call for assistance. We then meet as a conference to discuss and discern how best to respond to each situation.

Here are just a few examples:

- In one instance, a woman needed assistance getting into a supervised housing program. We helped her with the deposit and first month's rent. A year later, she has excelled at her job, purchased a car, and now has moved into a place of her own.
- In another situation, a parishioner, needed repairs to her home and we were able to help.
- A family with three children needed their electricity and gas restored and some help getting back on their feet.
- A family living in their car needed some car repairs and received the assistance needed to have their home (their vehicle) function safely again.

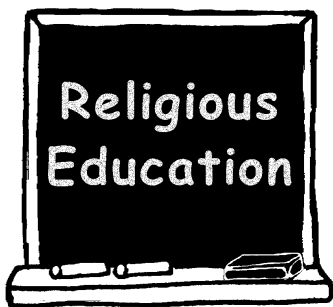

Without communication, parents don't know important things about their kids' lives, i.e., who they talk to, where they go, or who are their friends. These parents are far more likely to miss danger signs about potential bad influences or predators as well. ## Interesting Facts About Blessed Junípero Serra

- ♦ **Did you know** that Spanish Military Governor Fernando Rivera insisted that the Native Americans who killed Fray Luis Jayme and two other Spaniards at Mission San Diego in 1775 be severely punished before rebuilding the mission? Serra pleaded for leniency and finally a pardon was obtained for the natives and in particular for Carlos, the baptized Indian who led the revolt. "Great was our joy when we obtained a general amnesty...Because of our love of God, we set them free, so that they might [have repented] lead better lives," said Serra.

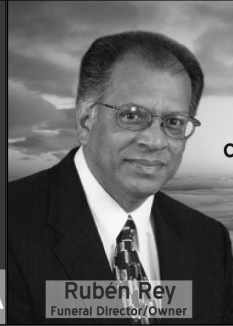

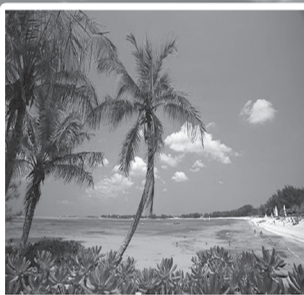

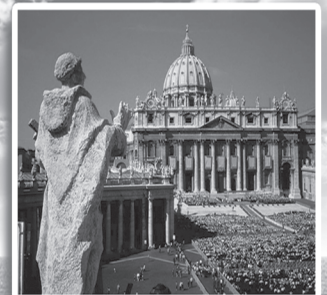
