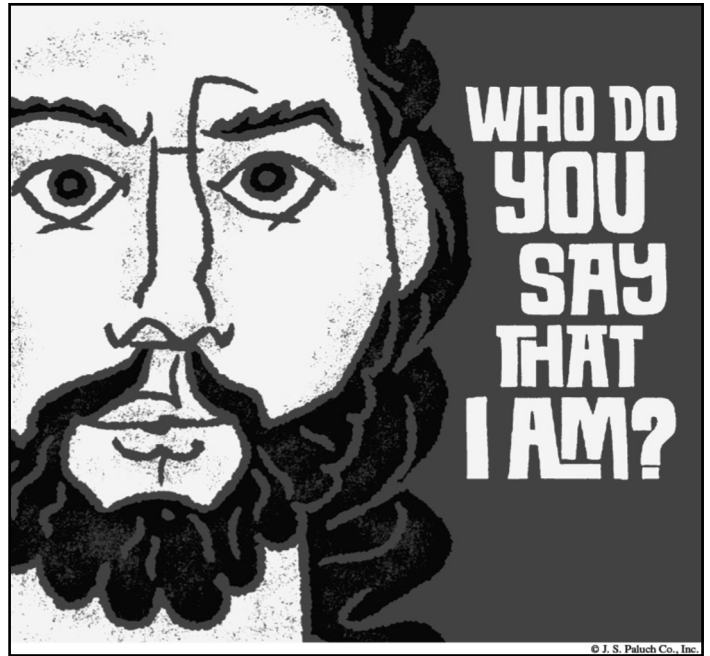

How can I explain my faith to others?

Do Catholics read the Bible? What are the Sacraments? Are Catholics Christians? How are all religions alike and how do they differ? How can I live out my faith in my daily life? What is the meaning and importance of every part of our Catholic Mass?

If you are a Catholic wanting to discover your faith and your traditions more deeply or are a Non-Catholic interested in deciding whether God is calling you to enter the Catholic Church, R.C.I.A. (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) may provide answers to your questions and the time you need to reflect and make some important decisions.

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (R.C.I.A.) is an eight-month process for those who would like to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church from other faiths, and for those seeking to better understand the Catholic faith. This is what one of our participants wrote about her experience:

“R.C.I.A. has explained all the aspects of Catholicism that I did not understand before, and much more! Even if you’ve been Catholic your whole life, this program will change your life, as I know it has certainly changed mine.”

R.C.I.A. is for you if you have a desire to grow spiritually, to mature in your faith, and would like to receive any of the following sacraments as an adult: baptism, communion, and/or confirmation. We meet every Monday evening from 6 to 8 PM in the Choir Loft. **Our first meeting will be on Monday, September 21st.** There is no charge to attend and no materials to be purchased. Materials will be given to every participant on the first day of class.

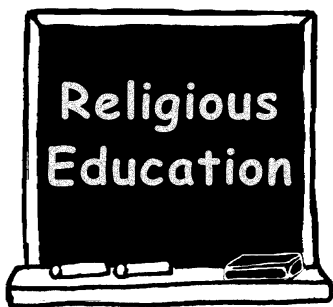

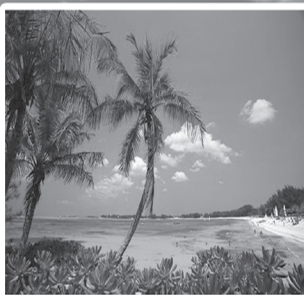
