SAN ROQUE PARISH FINANCIAL REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 14/15

(Period from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015)

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This has been another good financial year. Your generous giving of time, talent and resources has again allowed us to maintain our ministries' high standards and provide important charitable works.

Thanks, in large part, to a very generous parishioner, Offertory Income increased substantially and enabled us to pursue important new Growth and Development improvements.

Charity continues as an important mission of our parish. Recipients of our charitable works include Together-in-Mission, special Archdiocesan Programs, St. Vincent de Paul, and local parochial elementary and secondary schools.

This year's Together-in-Mission donations set a new record. Our assigned goal was exceeded by over \$8,221! Over-goal amounts were returned by the Archdiocese to our parish and used to help local parishes in need.

Ministry leaders and volunteers are the life blood of our parish. I am grateful for their countless hours of service and encourage everyone's participation. Ministry programs include: Religious Education, RCIA, Music, Eucharistic Ministry, Mass Servers, Counters, Hospitality, Ushers, Parish Council, Finance Council, St. Vincent de Paul and Sanctuary Guild. In addition, our small but wonderful staff is essential for the smooth operation of our parish.

Sidewalk lighting was installed along Calle Pinon Street to improve the nighttime safety of pedestrians using the parish hall and church. We have a similar plan to better illuminate the church parking lot area. Also, we responded to the need for a better, more portable, sound system to support parish hall events.

To conserve energy and reduce cost, the Sanctuary Guild provided funding for new, more efficient, LED lamps in the church. They provide better illumination with less heat, and when fully implemented, will reduce electricity costs by about \$3,000 per year.

In the current fiscal year we will be completing several projects involving the Church and outside areas. We will keep you informed along the way.

Next June marks the end of El Montecito School's five year sublease. They have been good tenants and we hope to agree on a new contract that will enable their continued presence here.

Our faith journey continues as we seek together to respond to God's call in our lives. I pray for God's continued blessings on you and your loved ones. I also remember in my prayers the parishioners who passed away this year.

As Catholics we find ourselves seeking the forgotten people, helping those in need, sharing our faith and embracing the culture of encounter proposed by Pope Francis. We are now being witnessed by millions as the “people’s Pope” role models. 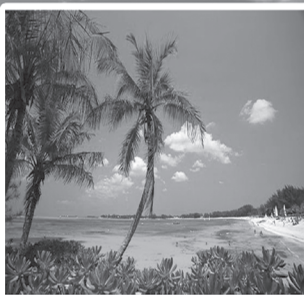

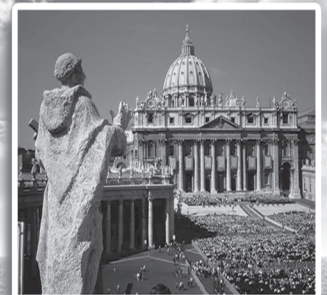
