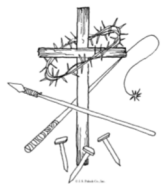

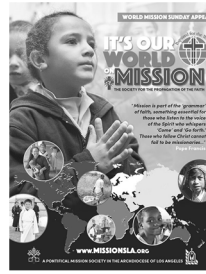
Are You Handicapped or Disabled?

This Weekend, October 18th, is World Mission Sunday

This is a day set aside for Catholics worldwide to recommit themselves to the Church's missionary activity through prayer and sacrifice. Saint John Paul II, Pope, described World Mission Sunday as "an important day in the life of the Church because it teaches how to give: as an offering made to God, in the Eucharistic celebration and for all the missions of the world" (see *Redemptoris Missio* 81). During a World Mission Sunday, The Pope said, "The offerings that will be collected are for a common fund of solidarity distributed, in the Pope's name, by the Society for the Propagation of the Faith among the missions and missionaries of the entire world." Every year the needs of the Catholic Church in the Missions grow and that is why the involvement and commitment of Catholics from around the world are so urgently needed. Offerings from Catholics in the U.S., on World Mission Sunday and throughout the year, are combined with offerings to the Propagation of the Faith worldwide. 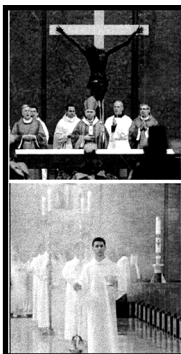

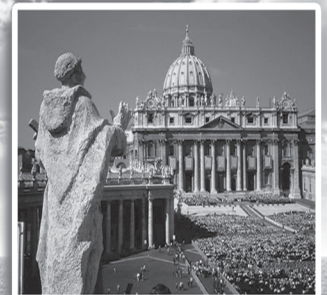
