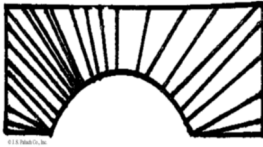

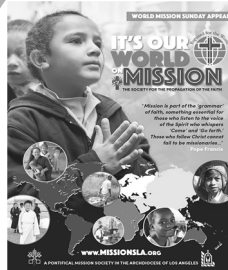
Come Join Our Parish Choir
