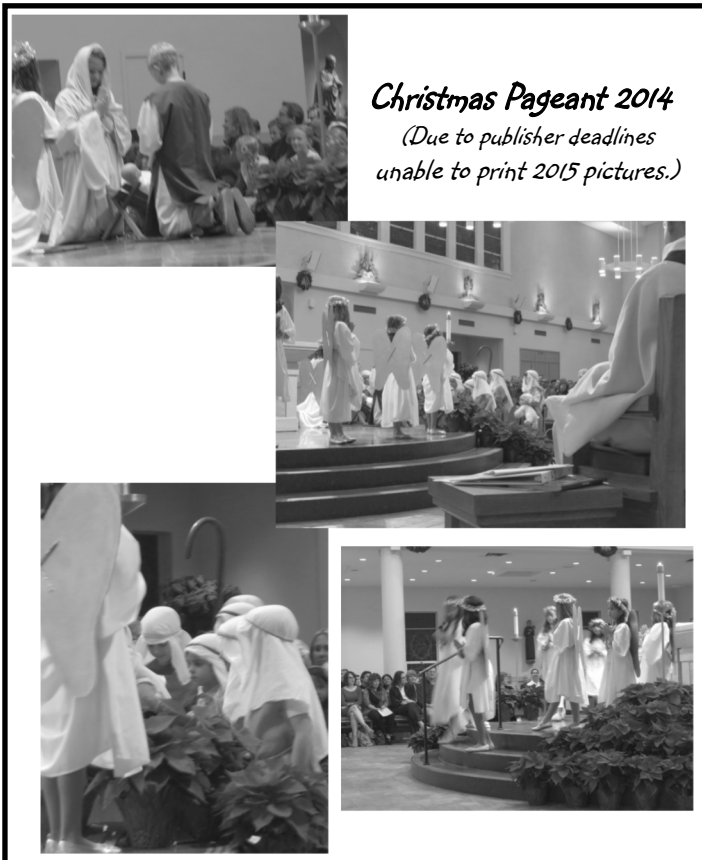

### **Take a time out to communicate**

Sometimes, kids need a place to go where they can say what they want, and they won't be immediately punished or have to deal with a negative reaction. It's important to make sure your child has such a space or time —after dinner conversations, an ice cream spot, riding home from school— where they can tell you what's on their mind, good or bad, and you can just listen and discuss, without taking the instant parental approach. If your children feel safe talking to you openly, you are better equipped to notice and handle any red flags in their lives. 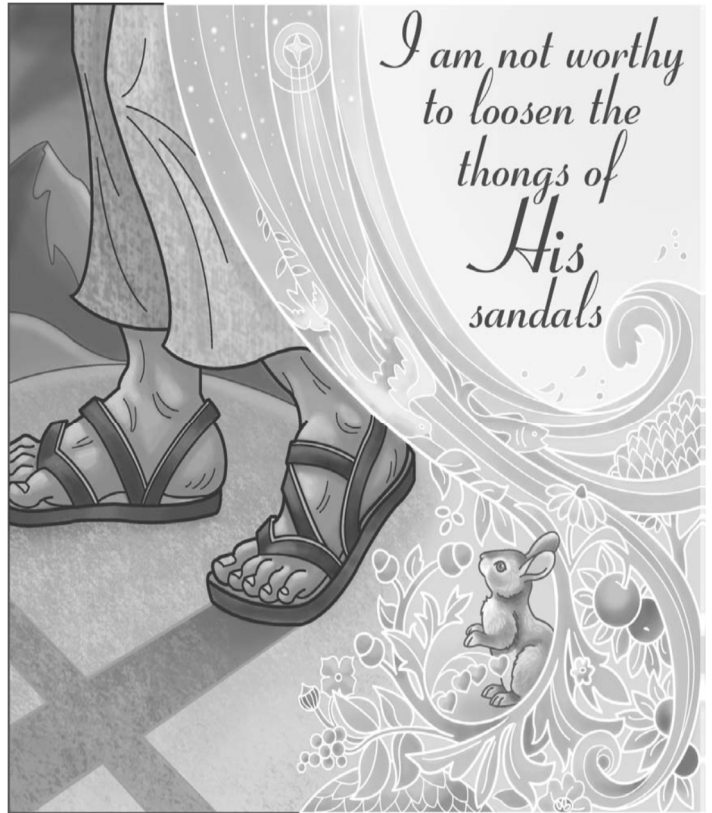

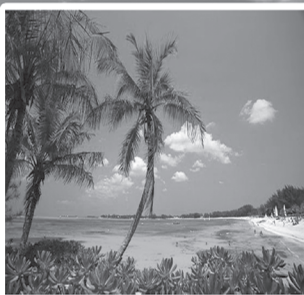
