

#### YOU ARE INVITED TO HOST THE ELIJAH CHALICE

Praying for vocations is the most powerful way to support vocations to the priesthood. Each week at our 10:30a.m. Sunday Mass, the celebrant will use the Elijah Chalice for the Precious Blood. A family, individual or couple will be called forward to receive the Elijah Chalice, which will be placed in a protective carrying case. They will receive a blessing and the Chalice home, placing it in an area of prominence. Each day during prayer time, they will pray for an increase in vocations. Suggested prayers for each day of the week will be included. Each Sunday, they will return the Elijah Chalice, for the next host(s).

A prayer journal travels with the Elijah Chalice, for those who may like to enter a thought, prayer or Scripture verse. Over time, this diary becomes a spiritual journey and blessing for the parish. Let us pray in thanksgiving for those men who have become our spiritual fathers. Their dedication and willingness to answer God's call enables us to become closer to God in so many ways, especially through the Eucharist. **BAPTISM** ~ *Blessings on our new parents and soon-to-be parents*. Baptisms are celebrated every Sunday at one of the parishes. Requirements include: Parents must attend a Baptism instruction class before the baptism; Godparents must be practicing Catholics, age 16 or older and have been confirmed. Please contact your parish office for the times, dates, more details about planning your baby's baptism.

**WEDDINGS** ~ *Congratulations on your engagement!* Please schedule an appointment with Adrienne Cullen, the Pastoral Associate at least 6 months prior to the wedding. Engaged couples contemplating marriage are required to take a marriage preparation course. Available programs may be found at http://www.bostoncatholic.org/MarriageMinistries

**MINISTRY TO HOMEBOUND** ~ *You are a valued member of the parish.* Our parishes have a ministry to those who are homebound and their caretakers. If you know a person who is homebound and would like Holy Communion brought to them, please call the rectory to arrange for a visit.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK** ~ *God heals us in mind, body and spirit.* This sacrament is intended to strengthen those being tried by illness. People who would benefit from the reception of this sacrament include: those preparing for serious surgery, the elderly whose frailty has become more pronounced, and those who begin to be in danger of death from sickness or old age. If you are planning surgery, please arrange for anointing before admission to the hospital. Please contact the office for further information.

**FOR THOSE WITH CELIAC DISEASE** ~ If you have celiac disease, please let us know. We have a supply of low-gluten altar bread available at all the churches for those who cannot tolerate gluten.

**R.C.I.A** ~ The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process through which non-baptized men and women become members of the Catholic Church. It is also open to those baptized in different faith traditions who are interested in becoming Catholic, or, for those who were baptized Catholic, but have yet to receive the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation.

**BEREAVEMENT** ~ A program has been developed to assist all individuals and families from all faiths in their journey through the grieving process. This process is based on the self- help format, where a facilitator leads the group in sharing of their pain and loss. They are also educated through personal experience, latest information from books, periodicals and articles and encourage them to also read and educate themselves that grief is definitely an individual process, that we all must pass through, that life has changed but not ended and with the support of God's love, grace and the group's help, they will survive. It is a nondenominational and spiritually based group, and is open to all.

**ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY** ~ Helps the poor by providing food, emergency relief and clothing for those struggling with daily life. Must be residents of Billerica.

**ENVELOPE SYSTEM** ~ The regular use of envelopes provides for a stable income to the church. This enables the pastor and finance committee to plan for repairs, future expansions and improvements. We urge all parishioners to make use of the envelopes.






