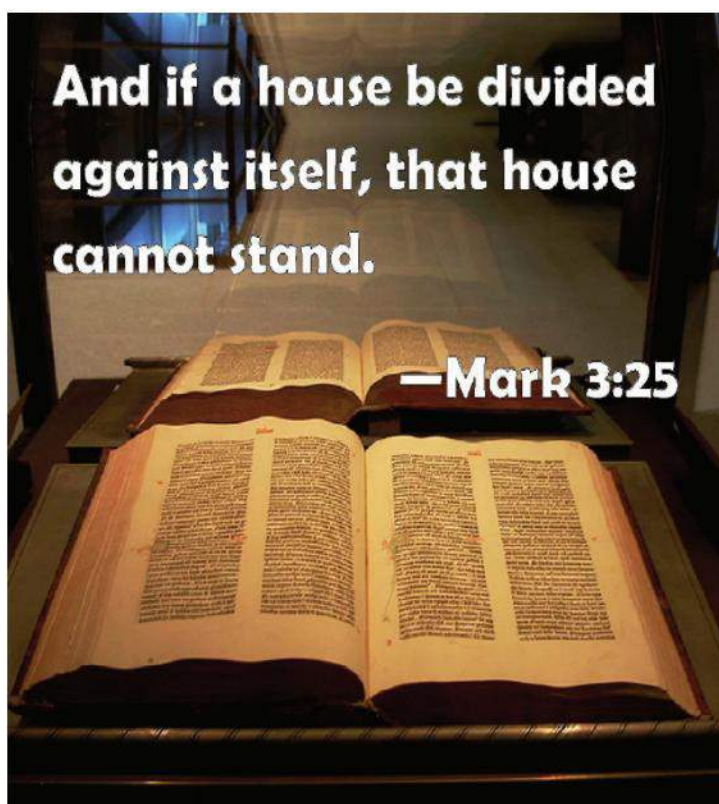

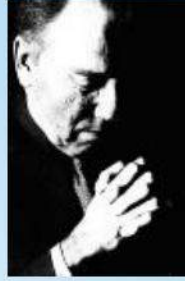

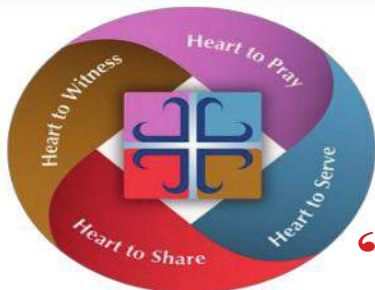

ST. CLEMENT OF ROME

An acquaintance of both Peter and Paul, Clement of Rome was an early Church leader. He was the third (or fourth) bishop of Rome, serving as head of the Church in the last decade of the first century.

Very little is known about Clement. Legend says he was martyred about 100 A.D. when the Emperor Trajan ordered that an anchor be tied to Clement’s neck and that he be thrown into the sea.

Clement is also considered one of the Church’s five Apostolic Fathers,” because he is a link between the apostles and later Church generations.

The Anchor Cross or Mariner’s Cross is also called St Clement’s Cross, in reference to the way Clement was said to have been martyred.

The anchor is also a symbol of safety. Early Christians began to use it as a symbol of hope, especially at the time of death.

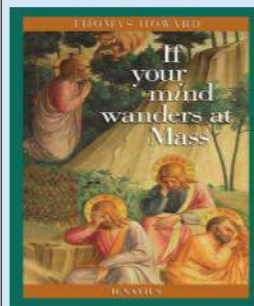

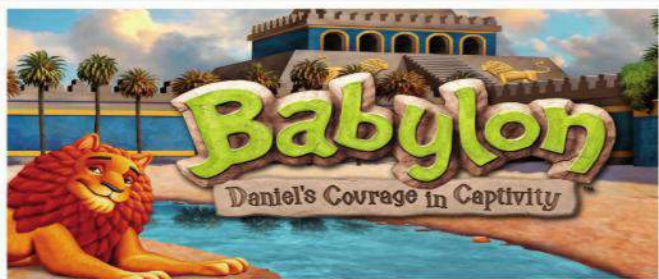

We have a Hearing Loop in the main body of the church and the Narthex to assist those with hearing loss, hear more clearly during services. A Hearing Loop is an assistive listening system that transmits sound directly into one's hearing aids or cochlear implants rather than depending on sound coming from the loudspeakers. To receive the Loop signal, manually activate your T-coil or telephone setting on your hearing aid or cochlear implant. If you don't know if you have a T-coil or whether yours is properly programmed, consult with your audiologist or hearing aid professional. If you don't wear hearing aids, please visit the Maintenance Team in the Narthex and ask to try a Loop receiver to test the sound.
