A Hearing Loop is an assistive listening system that transmits sound directly into one's hearing aids or cochlear implants rather than depending on sound coming from the loudspeakers. To receive the Loop signal, manually activate your T-coil or telephone setting on your hearing aid or cochlear implant. If you don't know if you have a T-coil or whether yours is properly programmed, consult with

your audiologist or hearing aid professional. If you don't wear hearing aids, please visit the Maintenance Team in the Narthex and ask to try a Loop receiver to test the sound


