



COLUMBUS DAY October 8

Columbus Day is a federal U.S. holiday that commemorates the voyage and landing of Italian explorer **Christopher Columbus** in the New World on October 12, 1492. In Christopher Columbus's day, scholars knew that the world was round; the fact dated from the ancient Greeks. People assumed that a ship traveling west from Europe would sail clear through to Asia.

However, many believed that such a westward journey was impossible. Columbus, an Italian, was convinced otherwise and persuaded King Ferdinand and Queen Isabella of Spain to sponsor his exploration and search for riches.

On October 12, 1492, Columbus landed on a small island in the Bahamas, convinced that he had reached his destination of Asia. Although he was not the first European to discover the Americas (Vikings, among others, had visited before), his journey sparked enthusiasm for European exploration of the hemisphere.

LITBIT

Receiving Communion Twice

Sometimes people ask if it is permissible to receive Holy Communion more than once a day. The norm is to receive the Lord once a day. This rule is meant to avoid a previous abuse during which people would "church - hop," going to receive Holy Communion from many churches a day so as to become "holier."

Occasions might arise, however, in which you find yourself celebrating at more than one Mass (for example, while attending a funeral, a wedding, a Confirmation, or another occasion of special significance). Then, of course, an additional communion is certainly approved.

ANSWER FOR THE QUESTION OF THE WEEK

C. is correct. Only the recipient of a private apparition is bound in conscience to follow it, if he thinks it is real. Anyone else is free to ignore a private apparition, even those who are convinced that a particular private apparition actually occurred. (This is not to say that you are free to ignore whatever true teachings are repeated through an apparition. Truth is truth, no matter where it appears.)
