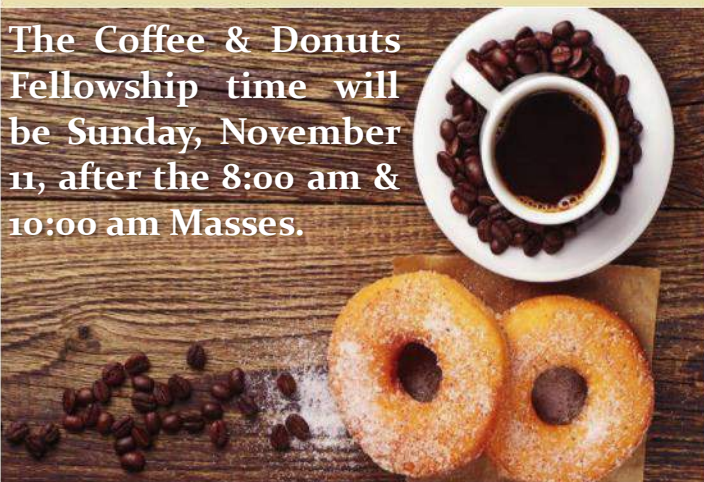

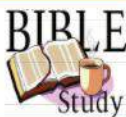

Before John Paul's funeral Mass in St. Peter's Square, hundreds of thousands of people had waited patiently for a brief moment to pray before his body, which lay in state inside St. Peter's for several days. The media coverage of his funeral was unprecedented. Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger, then dean of the College of Cardinals and later Pope Benedict XVI, presided at the funeral Mass and concluded his homily by saying; "None of us can ever forget how, in that last Easter Sunday of his life, the Holy Father, marked by suffering, came once more to the window of the Apostolic Palace and one last time gave his blessing urbi et orbi ('to the city and to the world') "We can be sure that our beloved pope is standing today at the window of our Father's house, that he sees us and blesses us."

Instead, our youth members will be going to an "Escape Room" An escape room, also known as an "escape game", is a physical adventure game in which players solve a series of puzzles and riddles using clues, hints, and strategy to complete the objectives at hand. Players are given a set time limit to unveil the secret plot which is hidden within the rooms.

LITBIT DISMISSALS FROM MASS

There can be many dismissals during liturgy. We all recognize that there is a dismissal at the end to send us out. There can also be a dismissal of the younger children to participate in the Liturgy of the Word for Children. This gives them the opportunity to hear and discuss the readings at their own age level.

During most of the year there is a dismissal every week for those who are part of the catechumenate process. Like the children during the Liturgy of the Word, they are dismissed for further discussion and reflection on the word of God. In some parishes the ministers to the homebound are dismissed early from the liturgy. They are sent out to bring Eucharist to those who are not able to participate with the community. So the community, through these ministers, goes to them.

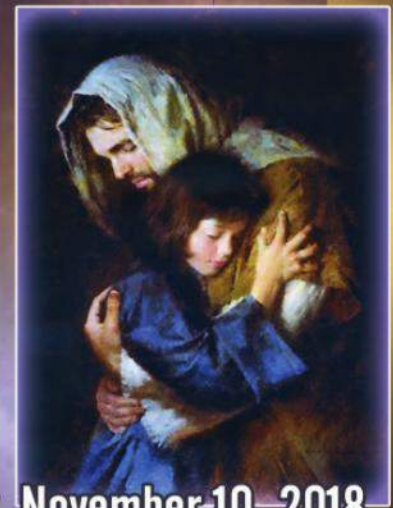
