We received approval from the Diocese to hire an architect.

When will Phase II construction begin? The tentative timeline for Phase II is as follows:

May 2019, we anticipate construction of the Family Life Center to begin. June 2020, construction of the church expansion is tentatively scheduled to begin.

It is estimated that each construction project will take one year to complete. It is important to emphasize that the tentative plan outlined is contingent upon Diocesan approval, appropriate governmental permitting and funding.
