

Presentation of the Priestly Fraternity of the Missionary of St. Charles Borromeo by Fr. Paolo Sottopietra

"Priests serving in the Fraternity of St. Charles Borromeo are called to be the bridge between heaven and earth as they help accompany the people of God in their journey towards God," said the General Superior of the Fraternity of St. Charles Borromeo, Fr. Paolo Sottopietra, at the presentation hosted at the Church of St. Peter on Saturday, January 20.

The Fraternity of St. Charles Borromeo was born from the fruits of the lay movement Communion and Liberation founded by Fr. Luigi Giussani and his efforts to teach the Catholic faith to

young people in Italian high schools. Fr. Paolo shared how Communion and Liberation helped him find the answers to all of his questions about faith, about the Mass, and how to live as a Christian—all ways he hopes our priests can help us learn and grow in our faith.

Fr. Paolo answered questions about the Fraternity, it's commitment to our parish and his affection for Minnesota where he went camping over twenty years ago. Fr. Paolo encouraged us to bring our faith where people work, live, struggle and are open to meet Christ. He reminded us we "belong to something greater" and with the Church we can feel at home where ever we are.




Peter - Keys To Following Jesus by Dr. Tim Gray


