The Diocese is currently comprised of over 470,000 Catholics and includes 74 parishes, 7 missions, 48 schools and early childhood centers, a university, and a variety of social service, health care, housing and pastoral ministries located within the five counties of Hillsborough, Pinellas, Pasco, Hernando and Citrus. The newly penned prayer emphasizes the theme of the 50th anniversary: Gratitude, Joy and Hope.

The Society of St Vincent de Paul would like to take the opportunity to thank the Parishioners for your generosity this past year. We have completed our Annual Report to National, and would like to share with you what you have helped us do for our neighbors.

This year, our Conference provided our neighbors with 15,336 volunteer hours, both during our open hours and those hours devoted behind the scenes with food deliveries, home visits, meetings etc. During these hours we helped:

- 3,471 families
- 12,661 individual neighbors, BY:
- ♦ Delivering 140,830 pounds of food;
- ♦ \$29,936 in utility payments so electric and water services weren't disconnected;
- \$3222 for gasoline or bus passes so neighbors could go to work, job interviews, or medical treatments;
- \$15,035 for Homeless needs;
- 44 home visits providing \$3,100 for furniture and household goods through the Thrift Store;
- ♦ Provided 176 families Thanksgiving dinners including \$15 gift card to purchase turkeys;
- We fed approximately 55 children each week during the school year through our Pack-a-Sack program.

To do all this and more, we received \$82,874 in donations from Parishioners of St James the Apostle, District Council, our own Vincentians, and spent \$75,308.

Thanks, so much again for your support, and May God continue to bless your generosity.
