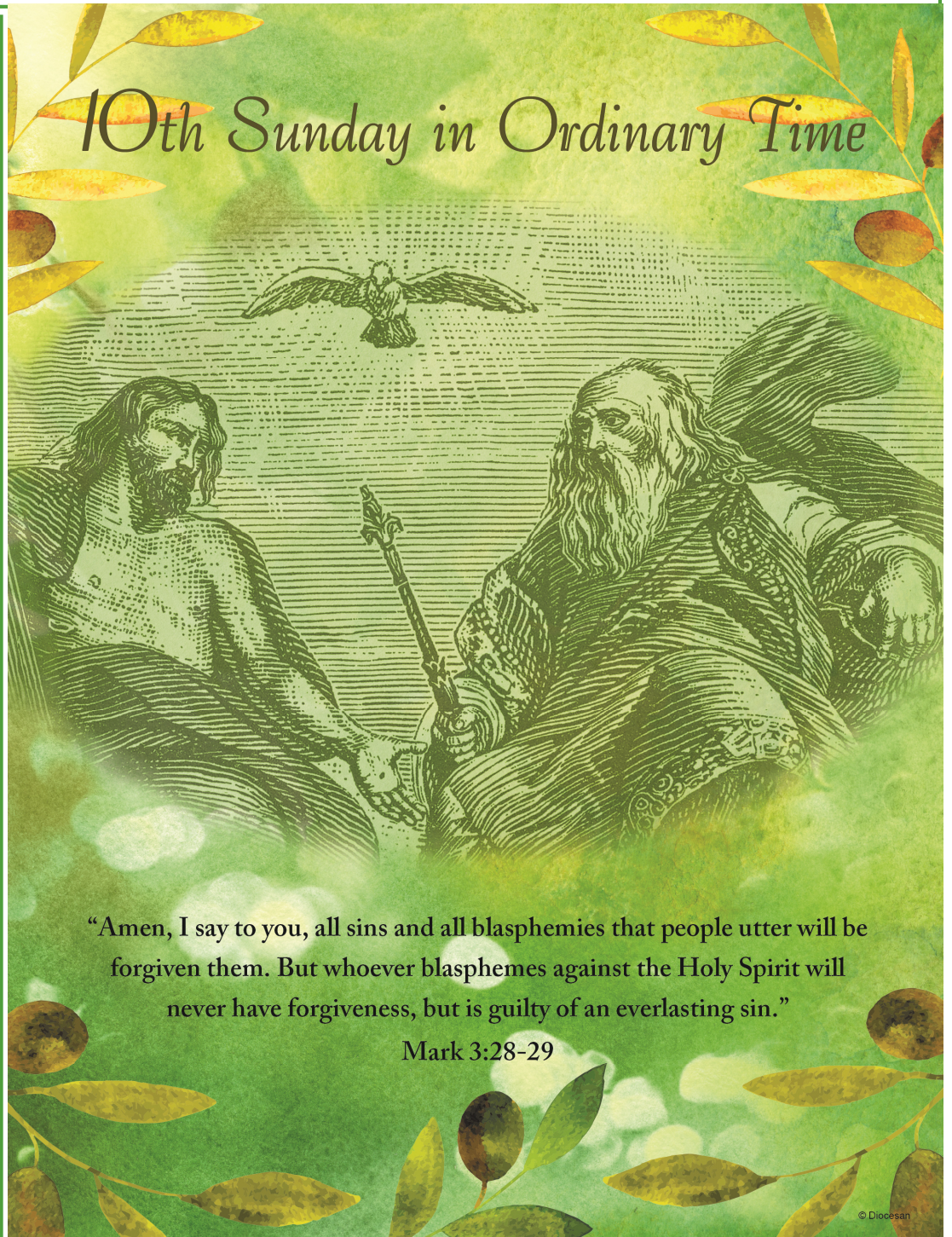

Unfortunately for the `people of Jesus' home town they were at a disadvantage. They saw Jesus grow up, they thought they knew Him, had Him all figured out. The reality was, they had no clue He was the Messiah, the Son of God.

How often do we do similar action in our own lives with our families and friends? Unless you are with someone all the time how can you say you fully know them? Each of us has events, revelations and changes that form us in to different people than we once were (even hours before). We do an amazing dis-service to anyone when we think we have them all figured out, yes, even in the case of spouses. Unless we take the time to care, to really see and recognize the changes in people, unless we see them with "new eyes" all the time—we do them and ourselves a great dis-service.

The town where Jesus grew really had no clue the gift that grew up before their very eyes. I pray we do not fall into a similar way of being. The moment we think we have anyone figured out we stifle their growth and our relationship with them. Jesus also always shows us in so may ways how he loves us, may we have the "new eyes" to see that.

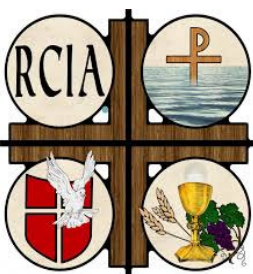
