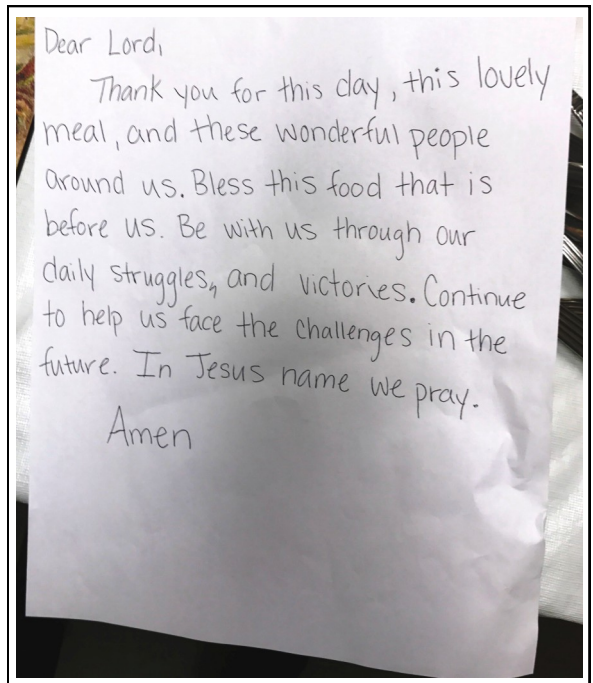

Health Ministry: Feed-a-Cold Feel Better Menu Specials



Appetizers:

Popsicles - made from 100% fruit juice. The cold soothes throat as well as hydrates to help body flush out the virus. Citrus fruit can boost the immune system as well. *Vegetable juices* - low sodium preferred! Provides antioxidants while hydrating. *Entrée: Broth Based Soup* - served hot to keep nasal passages moist; prevents dehydration and thins mucus/phlegm. *Chicken soup with vegetables added seems to reduce inflammation better than plain broth. *Vegetable Broth soup is equally effective for those who prefer meatless. *Beverage: Hot Tea (Green, Oolong or Black) or if caffeine bothers you we serve Herbal tea.* A bit of honey and/or lemon to soothe the throat can be added.

Spices and Condiments: The following are used in food preparation to temporarily relieve stuffiness and congestion by shrinking blood vessels in the nose and throat: Cayenne - Chili Pepper - Horseradish - Wasabi

Introductions to Sunday Readings

by Bishop Ken Untener, in collaboration with Catherine Haven and Fr. Bill Taylor



First Reading - Isaiah 8:23—9:3

Zebulun and Naphtali were two Jewish tribes who had settled in the northern area of the Holy Land. Eight centuries before Christ, this area experienced a bitter defeat at the hands of Assyria. The prophet Isaiah offers these defeated people hope by looking ahead to a day when they would be especially blessed. This northern area of the Holy Land was later known as Galilee, and Christians have seen Jesus as fulfilling this prophecy.

Second Reading - 1 Corinthians 1:10-13, 17

In his first letter to the Corinthians, Paul deals with issues the Church faces in every age. After Paul had founded this community and moved on, he heard of polarizations among the Corinthian Christians. In today's passage, he speaks bluntly to them about these divisions.

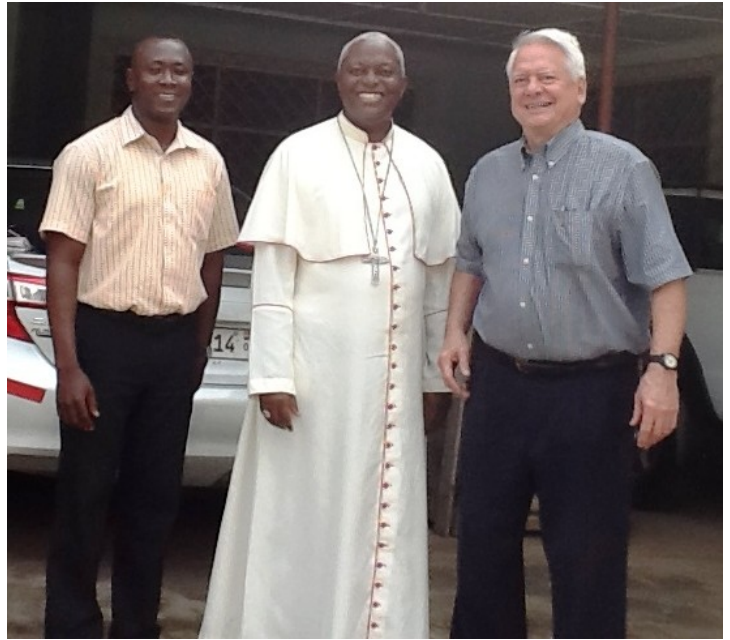
We Need Your Help!
