Health Ministry:

It's Time to Put an End to People Being Bored at Mass



It is impossible to be bored at Mass if you come to listen to what God has to say to you right now in your life. It doesn't matter how good or bad the homily is; God will speak to you through it. It doesn't matter how good or bad the music is; God will speak to you through it. Through the brokenness of the world, the imperfection of other people and situations, and even our own limited humanity, God wishes to speak to us. Here are two ideas:

1) Keep a Mass Journal Get yourself a small notebook and bring it to Mass next week. Then listen. Listen to the music, listen to the readings, listen to the preaching, listen to the prayers, and listen to the quiet of your heart. One thought or idea, one challenge or invitation will jump out at you. Write it down. Not five things. One thing. Spend the rest of the Mass praying about it. You'll leave Mass focused and energized.

2) Write out the Gospel Take a few minutes on Wednesday or Thursday each week and write out the Gospel reading for the following Sunday. You'll be amazed at how this increases your engagement with that reading. Nothing will have more impact on your life and your experience of Sunday Mass than opening yourself up to what God wishes to say to you.

First Reading - Ezekiel 37:12-14

The prophet Ezekiel spoke to God's people during their exile in Babylon, six centuries before Christ. In today's passage, the prophet (using the image of death and resurrection) assures the people that God will one day bring them back to their homeland.

Second Reading - Romans 8:8-11

Paul's letter to the Romans is his most detailed and important theological work. Throughout the letter, he teaches that Jesus overcame sin and the effects of sin. In today's passage, Paul stresses that through the Spirit, this saving power of Jesus is present and active in Christians of all times and places.
