

#### **Buying Safe Meds Online?**

Trying to cut health care costs? Many are looking for bargains



on medications and are ordering from online pharmacies outside the US. Be cautious, for only about 4% of the online drug outlets are safe while 50% of the medications sold online are counterfeit! *Order medication online safely:* 

- **1.** Check for the VIPPS seal. This means the site was screened and approved.
- 2. Look for '.pharmacy' at the end of the address.
- **3.** Make sure the site is licensed and based in the US. Even internet pharmacies claiming to be Canadian usually aren't, but are fake storefronts from third world countries.
- **4.** Check for a 1-800 number that is for a state-licensed pharmacist to answer questions.
- **5.** Make sure the site requires you to submit prescriptions.
- **6.** Look at privacy policies. Unless you know the site is safe, don't share social security numbers, credit card info, or personal medical history because you could be inundated with spam email or your computer infected by a virus.
- **7.** Be wary of extremely super low bargains.
- 8. Go to nabp.net for a list of accredited sites.

The next stage of RCIA is called "Mystagogy," from the Greek words meaning "to lead through the mysteries."


Traditionally Mystagogy extends throughout the Easter season until the feast of Pentecost.



#### **Introductions to Sunday Readings**

by Bishop Ken Untener, in collaboration with Catherine Haven and Fr. Bill Taylor



#### First Reading - Acts 2:42-47

Luke wrote a two-volume work: Volume One was his Gospel, and Volume Two was the Acts of the Apostles which describes the life of the Church after the Resurrection of Jesus. Every year, during the seven weeks of the Easter Season, the first reading is taken from the Acts of the Apostles. In today's passage, Luke gives an idealized description of early Christian community life.

#### Second Reading - 1 Peter 1:3-9

Our second reading during most of this Easter Season is taken from the first letter of Peter, which was addressed to Christians living in the northern part of what is today Turkey. These Christians found themselves out of step with the society in which they lived, and they felt abused and discriminated against. The resurrection of Jesus was held out to them as a basis of hope during their trials, which is why the Church chooses to read from this book during the Easter Season.


