## Health Ministry:

### Outdoor Time Here - Limit Pollution Exposure

Tiny specks of pollution in the air can cause big health problems.



*"Changing air quality is a bigger issue, but you can reduce your exposure."*

1. Check your area's Air Quality Index. Go to [airnow.gov](http://airnow.gov)
  2. Spend time exercising outdoors before or after rush hour traffic...before is better. Breathing heavily draws air and pollutants deeper into the lungs.
  3. Do not exercise within 400 yards of a busy roadway.
  4. When driving, avoid heavy traffic areas if possible. Diesel exhaust of trucks and buses is especially dirty.
  5. When sitting in traffic: close windows, set fan on recirculate and replace car air filters regularly. HEPA air filters are recommended.
  6. Don't smoke indoors. Actually, don't smoke at all! Many are aware of the harm caused by second hand-smoke. Research now suggests that third-hand smoke toxins which are caught in drapes, furniture, etc. can be harmful as well.

### Introductions to Sunday Readings

#### First Reading - Acts 2:14, 22-33

None of the Scripture readings during the seven-week Easter Season are from the Old Testament. But the Acts of the Apostles, which is read every Sunday during Easter, frequently quotes Old Testament passages which the early Christians saw as fulfilled in Jesus. Today's reading gives part of Peter's sermon at the first Pentecost. Peter quotes from Psalm 16, which like most Psalms, was popularly thought to have been written by David.

#### Second Reading - 1 Peter 1:17-21

The Christians for whom the first letter of Peter was written were recent converts from paganism. They found themselves a small minority in pagan surroundings. Their neighbors and local authorities made life miserable for them. Today's passage offers encouragement by reminding them that Jesus died and rose for them.

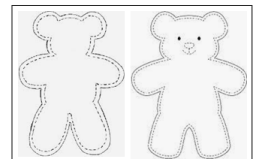
