Health Habits that Parents Can Pass on to the Next Generation



Parents! You pass more than your genes to your kids, for you pass on your habits, too - good and bad.

1. Don't skip breakfast; Watch sugar content.
2. Drink water, not soda pop.
3. Get the whole family moving: ride bikes, walk, play games outside. Keep it fun.
4. Get kids off the sofa. Limit TV, video games and computer time to 2 hours per day.
5. Read every day. Begin reading to kids as early as 6 months of age.
6. Make dinner-time a family-time if possible.
7. Make a game of reading food labels to learn contents of products.
8. Encourage playing with friends to learn the social skills of communication/cooperation.
9. Keep things positive even while experiencing setbacks. Let children know what they do well and not dwell on what they can't.

Introductions to Sunday Readings

First Reading - Acts 2:1-11

Pentecost was a Jewish feast that celebrated the beginning of the harvest. It took place 50 days after the feast of Passover. Jewish pilgrims came to Jerusalem from all over the ancient world for the celebration. Today we hear how Pentecost became a Christian feast.

Second Reading - 1 Corinthians 12:3-7, 12-13

Paul's first letter to the Corinthians responds to a letter they wrote to him. They had asked him how to deal with the diversity of gifts in the community, and the rivalries and jealousies that inevitable arose. In today's passage, he uses a comparison that we will recognize immediately.

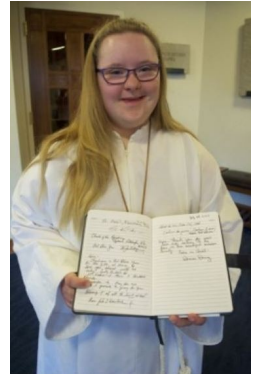

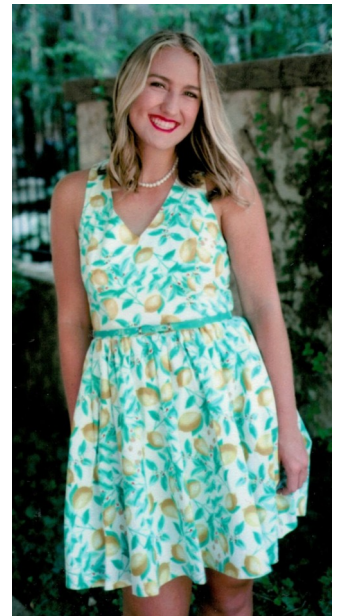
