\*Discipline - "As a result of being disciplined as a child, I now suffer from a psychological condition known as respect for others."



#### **Introductions to Sunday Readings**





The events in today's reading take place as the Israelites are camped on the shore of the Jordan River ready to enter the Promised Land. In his farewell speech, Moses makes it clear that when they settle in their new land they must never forget all the wonderful things God did for them during their 40 years in the desert.

#### Second Reading - 1 Corinthians 10:16-17

The Jewish people believed that when they sacrificed an animal to God and then ate a portion of the sacrifice themselves, they were in communion with God to whom they had given the other portion. Applying this to the Eucharist, Paul reminds us that when we received Holy Communion, we become one with the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross.
