## Health Ministry:

### Dads-Pops-Fathers Are Still Needed!

Dad's approach to parenting tends to be a little different than a mom's.

Dads tend to encourage competition, independence, achievement, healthy risk-taking and firmer discipline. Moms tend to promote equity, security, collaboration, and safety, and while she usually disciplines more often is less firm but tries to reason and rely on children's emotional attachment to control their behavior.



### Dad's approaches served with humor:

\***Competition** - "Hustle until your haters ask if you are hiring."

\***Independence** - "My father didn't ask me to leave home. He took me down to the highway and pointed."

\***Achievement** - "I'm doing something for my dad that he has wanted for years...I'm getting a job."

\***Risk Taking** - "Say yes to new adventures.

Take calculated risks. That's quite different from being rash."

\***Discipline** - "As a result of being disciplined as a child, I now suffer from a psychological condition known as *respect for others*."

## Introductions to Sunday Readings

### First Reading - Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14-16

The events in today's reading take place as the Israelites are camped on the shore of the Jordan River ready to enter the Promised Land. In his farewell speech, Moses makes it clear that when they settle in their new land they must never forget all the wonderful things God did for them during their 40 years in the desert.

### Second Reading - 1 Corinthians 10:16-17

The Jewish people believed that when they sacrificed an animal to God and then ate a portion of the sacrifice themselves, they were in communion with God to whom they had given the other portion. Applying this to the Eucharist, Paul reminds us that when we received Holy Communion, we become one with the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross.
