## Health Ministry:

### You Tick Me Off

From one tick to you:



- \* I am most common from April to September, but can be active in winter.
- \* I don't jump, fly or fall from trees onto your head and back. I latch onto your foot or leg and crawl up.
- \* I like to feed around the neck, head and ears, for skin is thinner there and it's easier to attach.
- \* Many of us are the size of a small, dark apple seed. Only the Deer Tick transmits Lyme Disease and it's smaller - like a freckle. It's brown and has no pattern on it's back.
- \* Those of us who are infected need to be attached 36 to 48 hours to transmit Lyme Disease. **Don't panic!** Less than 5% of bites result in infection.
- \* I hate it when you wear protective clothing, apply a 20% DEET product, check for me after coming indoors and then remove me: *Use pointed tweezers and grab next to the skin. Don't squeeze on the back end, for germs get pushed to front end of me and into you. Pull the tick out, don't yank. Place the tick in a sealed plastic bag and put it in the garbage or flush it down the toilet. Wash the area with soap and water and check the area for infection each day for several days. Although I am just a lowly tick and usually just a nuisance, do take me seriously.* CDC/Consumer Reports/TickEncounter Resource Center

**First Reading - Isaiah 55:10-11**

Because the Israelites were exiled in the pagan land of Babylon, the assuring words that God had previously spoken to them now seemed empty. In today's passage, the prophet Isaiah will use an image from nature to describe how God's word always bears fruit and comes true no matter how unlikely it may seem.

**Second Reading - Romans 8:18-23**

As we continue reading from the eighth chapter of Paul's letter to the Romans, he tells us that sin affected not only human beings but also all creation, and the coming of Christ had a healing effect on both. It is evident that Paul is not pessimistic about this world.




### SUMMER UPDATE

While many think the summer slows down for schools, in many ways, the activity actually picks up. Without students, we are able to complete facility upgrades and maintenance that is difficult to do during the school year. Projects being worked on include:

- A new faculty bathroom on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor (until now, the only faculty bathrooms were on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor)
- New partitions and doors in 3 of the 4 student bathrooms (these were original to the building)
- Removal of bulletin boards, chalk boards, etc. from the walls of the future chapel
- Painting of the future chapel
- Replacing the remaining lights in the building with energy efficient LED lights
- Replacing all of the outdoor lighting with energy efficient lights
- Replacing the rotted railroad ties out front with a new concrete wall which is in keeping with the remainder of the building
- The addition of another set of volleyball poles in the gym so that we can have two teams practicing at the same time
- The bleacher project!!
- Replacement of the curb in the parking lot to help with the flow of rain water onto the football field
- Finally, the baseball field has received a much needed facelift by Leo Bell who made this his Eagle Scout project. Thanks Leo!!


