



Introductions to Sunday Readings

by Bishop Ken Untener, in collaboration with Catherine Haven and Fr. Bill Taylor First Reading - Isaiah 22:19-23



In Jerusalem eight centuries before Christ, God spoke through the Prophet Isaiah who is told to address a problem. The "master of the palace" the equivalent of a secretary of state — was a man named Shebna. God says that he is to be demoted because he used this office for his own advantage. We will hear a description of the investiture of Shebna's successor, Eliakim.

Second Reading - Romans 11:33-36

Today's reading concludes a part of Paul's letter to the Romans in which he agonizes over the fate of Jewish people who have not accepted Christ. Paul simply leaves the matter in God's hands, and closes with a hymn that talks of the mysterious ways of Divine Providence. You will notice that the ending of this hymn is similar to the way we end every Eucharistic prayer.

Death in Combat Vietnam War hero and U.S. Navy chaplain remembered as Holy See considers Cause for sainthood. This September marks the 50th anniversary of the death on a Vietnam



battlefield of Father Vincent R. Capodanno, M.M., Servant of God. To commemorate the occasion, this Wednesday, August 30th at 10:00 PM EWTN will air the world premiere of a new 90-minute documentary film, Called and Chosen -Father Vincent R. Capodanno. This film about the U.S. Navy chaplain's extra-ordinary life and death serving U.S. Marines in combat was created in partnership between the Father Vincent Capodanno Guild and EWTN and was produced by award-winning filmmaker James C. Kelty (Kateri and Serra; Ever Forward Never Back). At 8:00 PM that same night, EWTN Live will air a one-hour panel discussion on Father Capodanno. The discussion will be hosted by Father Mitch Pacwa, S.J and includes Mr. Jim Kelty, producer of the new film; Capt. George Phillips, USMC (Ret.), Board Chairman of the Father Capodanno Guild; and Ms. Mary Preece, Vice-Postulator of Father Vince Capodanno's Cause for Canonization. The film will re-air at 3:00 PM on Saturday, September 2nd and Labor Day Monday, September 4th. Set your DVRs!

Following is an excerpt from the National Catholic Register article, "Fr. Vincent Capodanno's Story of Heroism Being Filmed for TV" - That day, on a small, bloody knoll during a fierce battle with Marines greatly outnumbered by the North Vietnamese, it took more than 25 enemy bullets to stop Navy chaplain Father Capodanno, already severely wounded, as he moved about the field bringing comfort to all, ministering to the dying, and rescuing the wounded of "Mike" Company's 1st, 2nd and 3rd platoons. **Parishioner Ed Combs** was serving as Second Lieutenant in Riffle Company "Mike" during that battle.
