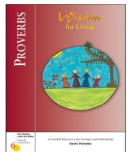

We often think of a pet as a dog or cat, but the list can include fish, hamsters, rabbits, horses, reptiles, fish and the list goes on. Whichever "pet" fits your lifestyle, each brings its own gift:

- * A child who has a pet learns to care for another and is often less self-centered.
- * When exposed to a pet (mainly dog/cat) in infancy, a child's risk for developing certain allergies is decreased.
- * Pets teach responsibility - have to make an effort to care for the pet on a regular basis.
- * Pets provide companionship and promote feelings of well being.
- * Pets lessen feelings of isolation / loneliness.
- * Pets speed up recovery after an illness.
- * Pets are a social lubricant; they are often the topic of conversation.
- * Pets improve fitness due to increased activity.
- * Pets build family bonds as they are often the focus of family activities.

Introductions to Sunday Readings

First Reading - Ezekiel 18:25-28

Ezekiel was an Old Testament prophet who ministered to the Jewish people exiled in Babylon six centuries before Christ. In today's reading, he takes up a question we have probably asked ourselves: Is God fair or unfair in his dealings with people?

Second Reading - Philippians 2:1-11

Paul wrote from prison to his Christian converts in Philippi, a city in what is today northeastern Greece. While he was in prison, the Philippians had sent someone to bring money for his support and to stay with him. Paul thanks them by quoting an early Christian hymn which he felt described Christ as a model for the way all Christians should live.

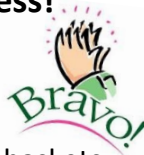
