DUI-E Danger - What's That?



Driving Under the Influence of Electronics. Driving is the most dangerous thing most of us do on a daily basis and it deserves our full attention. Driving distractions are numerous: besides those driving under the influence of alcohol, drugs, prescription medications and inexperience, let's add those eating, drinking, grooming, and smoking while behind the wheel. And if this is not enough, include electronics which are present in today's cars...radio, temperature control, touch screens, Netflix, Google Maps and the list is growing. Probably the most dangerous electronic device - the handheld cell phone we bring along with us. Even though many of these devices can be controlled by "hands-free technology" (voice command) drivers at times develop a kind of "tunnel vision," losing focus on the actual task of driving...that is in *attentional* driving. There is a limit of human multi-*talking* abilities. Distracted driving is now the leading cause of car accidents in America. To put it in perspective, "Taking your eyes off the road for about 5 seconds is long enough to cover the distance of a football field at 55 miles per hour." If facts don't sway your thinking, perhaps church humor might: "HONK IF YOU LOVE JESUS. TEXT WHILE DRIVING IF YOU WANT TO MEET HIM." *Dayton Daily News/avvo.com/church sign*
