

#### Second Reading - 1 Thessalonians 5:16-24





**The Colors of Advent** Advent has a two-fold character: as a season to prepare for Christmas when Christ's first coming to us is remembered, and as a season when that remembrance directs our minds and hearts to await Christ's second coming at the end of time. Advent is a period of devout and joyful expectation. This is very different from the penitential nature of Lent. Therefore, some parishes, Holy Family included, use blue violet during Advent to preserve the traditional use of purple, while providing a visual distinction between the purple or red violet of Lent.
