Health Ministry:

Hazards of Raw Pet Food



"Think twice about putting your pooch or kitty on a raw meat diet. These foods may contain bacteria (salmonella, E.coli Campylobacter) or parasites that could infect your pet...and you." If infected you may well face 7 to 10 days of cramps, diarrhea, nausea/vomiting. The young, the old and those with weak immune systems are most at risk.

Raw food pet diets are trendy, but many veterinarians discourage the practice:

- * No scientific studies have shown the benefits of raw food diets.
- * Diet may not meet pets overall nutritional needs (mineral deficiencies).
- * Increased chance of developing foodborne illnesses for pet and owner.

If you decide to feed your pet a raw food diet:

- + Keep raw pet foods separate from other foods to avoid cross contamination.
- + Keep raw meat frozen until used.
- + Wash well all working surfaces, utensils, hands and all other items that came in contact with raw food.
- + Consult your veterinarian first before feeding your pet a raw food diet.

Introductions to Readings

by Bishop Ken Untener, in collaboration with Catherine Haven and Fr. Bill Taylor



First Reading - Acts 3:13-15, 17-19

Chapter three of the Acts of the Apostles describes how Peter and John healed a lame man who sat begging each day at the gate of the temple. The people were astonished at this miracle. Peter used the opportunity to give a sermon encouraging the people to believe in Jesus. Today we hear a portion of that sermon.

Second Reading - 1 John 2:1-5a

Each Sunday during this Easter Season, we are reading from the first letter of John. It was written for the community from which the fourth Gospel emerged. At the time, this community was seriously divided. Some members believed that as long as you had faith in Jesus, it didn't matter what you did in daily life. Today's passage deals with that issue.

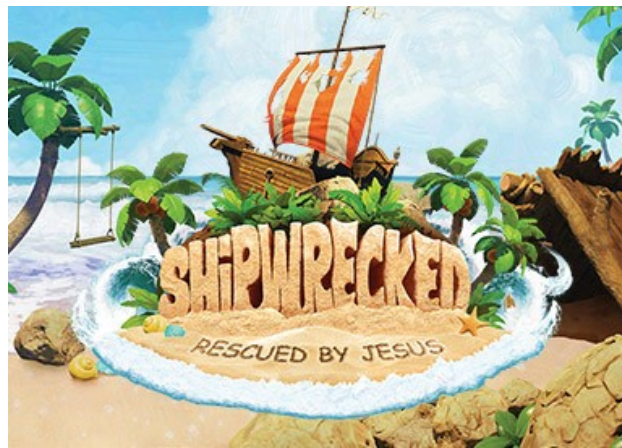
