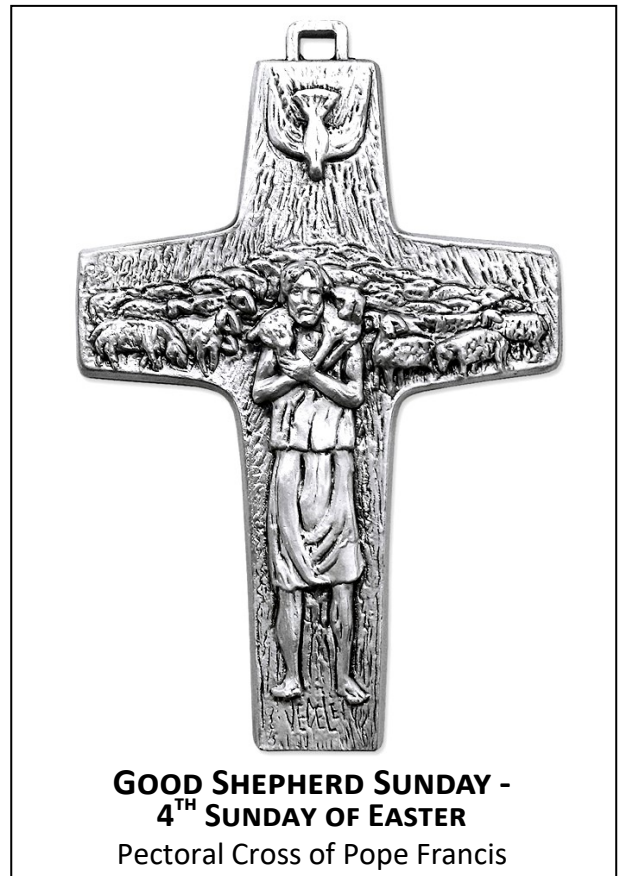

## Health Ministry:

### Experiencing Anxiety?

Anxiety - an uncomfortable feeling of nervousness or worry about something that is happening or might happen in the future. Anxiety can be both a blessing and a curse. A little bit of anxiety can nudge us forward to accomplish a goal, but too much anxiety can be paralyzing... taking a toll on emotional and physical health. Perhaps Max Lucado expressed it well:



*It's 2:30 in the morning. Everyone is asleep - that is except you! Thoughts race through your mind. The green numbers on the clock are the only lights in your room, indeed the only lights in your life. Another hour passes. What a mess! What does all this anxiety, all this restlessness mean? Simply this - you are human. It does not mean your parents failed you or vice versa. And this is important: it doesn't mean you are not a Christian. Jesus battled anxiety, for heaven's sake! In the Garden of Gethsemane he prayed three times that he wouldn't have to drink of the cup (Matthew 26:36-44). He was anxious, but he didn't stay anxious. He entrusted his fears to his heavenly Father and completed his earthly mission with faith. And he will help us to do likewise."*

### Introductions to Readings

#### First Reading - Acts 4:8-12

Early in the Acts of the Apostles, Peter and John healed a lame man who sat begging at the temple gate. This miracle led to their arrest, and they were brought before the Sanhedrin. In today's passage, we hear Peter speaking boldly about Jesus to these Jewish leaders. In these few sentences, Peter presents the very heart of the Christian message.

#### Second Reading - 1 John 3:1-2

During the Easter Season, we are reading from the first letter of John. Today's passage reminds us about something both John and Paul emphasized: Jesus has made it possible for us to be God's sons and daughters, not just in some future life, but here and now.

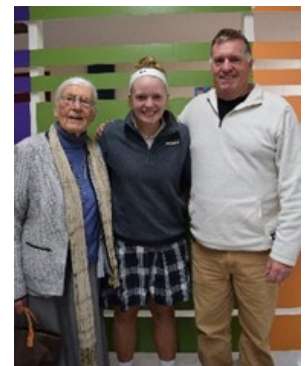

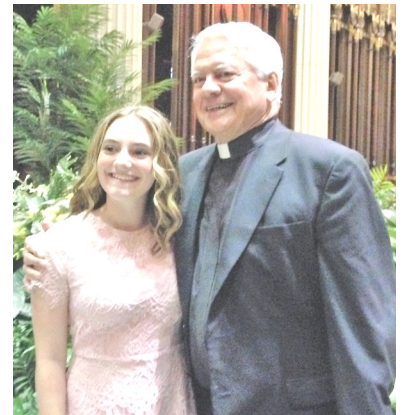
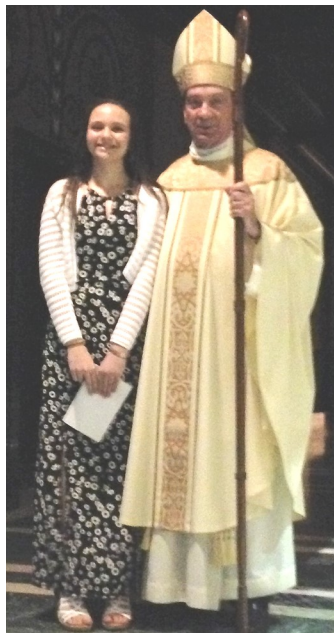
