## Health Ministry: Insect Bites & Stings Call 911 if child:

• Has been bitten or stung and has sudden hives, swelling in face, difficulty breathing, dizziness or fainting.

• Has had a serious allergic reaction to insect bite or sting before.

#### Call doctor if:

- Child been bitten near mouth.
- Area gets larger, redder or oozing. Most times insect stings/bites in young children may be painful, frightening or irritating, but rarely cause for concern.

#### **Treatment:**

- **1. Remove stinger.** *Scrape* with fingernail or credit card. Don't push stinger with finger or tweezers can inject more venom.
- 2. Clean area with mild soap and water.
- 3. Treat symptoms swell, pain, itch:

## **Introductions to Readings**

by Bishop Ken Untener, in collaboration with Catherine Haven and Fr. Bill Taylor First Reading - Jeremiah 23:1-6



The prophet Jeremiah preached some 500 years before Christ, at a time when unworthy kings ruled the Jewish people. He looked to the day when God would raise up a good shepherd from the House of David. Later, the Gospel writers emphasized that Jesus was born of the House of David, and Christians have seen him as the fulfillment of this prophecy.

## Second Reading - Ephesians 2:13-18

Our second reading is from the letter to the Ephesians. Ephesus was a community made up of Jewish people who had become Christians, and Gentiles who had become Christians. In this part of the letter, the author is addressing Gentiles — people who were once "far off" from the true God, but have "come near." As a result, both Jews and Gentiles are together as one "new person," namely the Body of Christ which is the Church.


