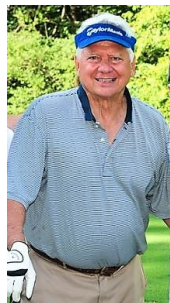
## Holy Family Parish 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Golf Outing Sunday, August 12<sup>th</sup> Wildwood Golf Club

## Health Ministry: Insect Bites & Stings

### Call 911 if child:

- Has been bitten or stung and has sudden hives, swelling in face, difficulty breathing, dizziness or fainting.
- Has had a serious allergic reaction to insect bite or sting before.



### Call doctor if:

- Child been bitten near mouth.
- Area gets larger, redder or oozing.

Most times insect stings/bites in young children may be painful, frightening or irritating, but rarely cause for concern.

### Treatment:

**1. Remove stinger.** Scrape with fingernail or credit card. Don't push stinger with finger or tweezers - can inject more venom.

**2. Clean area with mild soap and water.**

**3. Treat symptoms - swell, pain, itch:**

Ice area for 10 minutes, remove for 10 minutes, then repeat; elevate area, if arm or leg; use pain relief formulated for babies or children, like Tylenol, Advil, and Motrin; apply a mixture of baking soda and water or calamine lotion for itch

## Introductions to Readings

by Bishop Ken Untener, in collaboration with Catherine Haven and Fr. Bill Taylor



### First Reading - Jeremiah 23:1-6

The prophet Jeremiah preached some 500 years before Christ, at a time when unworthy kings ruled the Jewish people. He looked to the day when God would raise up a good shepherd from the House of David. Later, the Gospel writers emphasized that Jesus was born of the House of David, and Christians have seen him as the fulfillment of this prophecy.

### Second Reading - Ephesians 2:13-18

Our second reading is from the letter to the Ephesians. Ephesus was a community made up of Jewish people who had become Christians, and Gentiles who had become Christians. In this part of the letter, the author is addressing Gentiles — people who were once "far off" from the true God, but have "come near." As a result, both Jews and Gentiles are together as one "new person," namely the Body of Christ which is the Church.

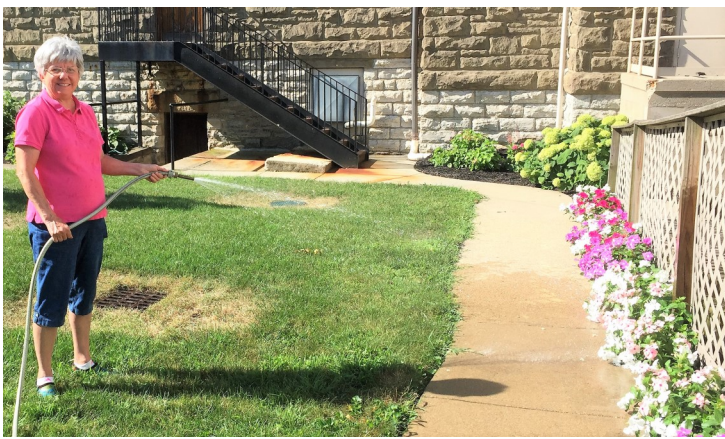
