

**Extracurricular Activities** 

- Find the Balance

While extracurricular activities can be a positive way for a child to develop his talents, they can also seriously detract from his childhood. Organized activities have stepped in to replace unsupervised "free time" which we're no longer comfortable allowing children to have. Benefits of organized activities:

\* Keep kids busy. Young children do well with structure. \* Protection against more dangerous activities. The couple of hours after school are the highest risk time for dangerous behavior because kids are often unmonitored, especially if parents work. \*Break from studies/explore new interests. \*Widen social circle.

#### **Drawbacks of organized activities:**

\*Overscheduling not to be taken lightly.

It can demand more time than many students and parents can manage. \*Loss of downtime to relax. \*Cost. Registration fees, equipment, uniforms. \*Over involvement can lead to feelings of anxiety especially if competitive performance. \*There are stress signs which indicate when it's too much: Headaches, stomach pains, fatigue, missing school assignments, mood/behavior changes, weight gain or loss, changes in sleep. In younger children bed wetting, thumb sucking or hair twirling. \*Child Mind Institute/Rowen U/Classroom\*

#### **Introductions to Readings**

by Bishop Ken Untener, in collaboration with Catherine Haven and Fr. Bill Taylor



First Reading - Isaiah 35:4-7

This section of the book of Isaiah contains the words of a prophet to God's people exiled in Babylon. He encourages them that one day they will be free to return home to Jerusalem. This journey will be through the desert, but God will transform this barren wasteland in order to ease their passage home.

#### Second Reading - James 2:1-5

The letter of James was written about 50 years after the death and resurrection of Jesus. It was addressed not to a particular community, but to Christians everywhere. Because of this, it is part of a group of New Testament letters called *catholic epistles* - meaning that the author wrote them for all Christians. One of the trademarks of the epistle of James is the need to *act* on God's word, not just *listen* to it.



#### A SVDP Outreach Overview

Our parish SVDP is a vibrant group of volunteers who serve our local community in Middletown. Our focus today will highlight the furniture ministry.

We receive calls for assistance via messages left on the Help Line. Within 24 to 48 hours, our Outreach coordinators are contacting the persons by phone to schedule a home visit to assess their needs. Many of our clients have been residing in homeless shelters and are now ready to move forward with independent apartment living. Literally, they're released with nothing but a bag of clothes and personal items. Within a week SVDP volunteers arrive with beds, couches, chairs, kitchen items, lamps and whatever miscellaneous items that are available. A lot of our clients are young mothers with children trying to get a new start on life. None of this community outreach would be possible without the generous donations from our parish. The need is great in our community and the SVDP group welcomes anyone interested in volunteering with us.


