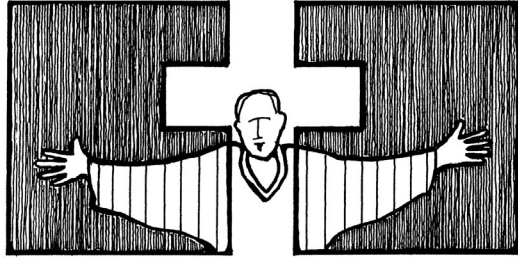

Bingo every night of the festival

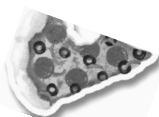
Every night of the festival, we have bingo starting after dinner (about 7:30 PM) inside our air-conditioned Activities Building.

Cards are three for 50¢. Stop by and join in the four days of fun at Festival 2016!

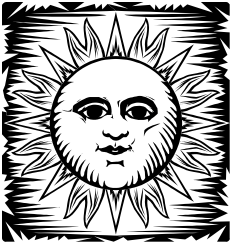
