**Parish Membership:** New parishioners are always welcome! Call the Parish Office for a census form.



**From the Desk of the Administrator**

Sisters and brothers, I have been reflecting and praying A LOT about violence in our world. In some ways, without obsessing about it, it causes me great concern and should you as well. So let me share what I have been thinking.

What is the cause of violence in our world? I am vehemently sure it is because we don't truly have Jesus Christ at the center of our lives. If we always lived like Him, why would there be hatred towards others? Jesus loved everyone. He loved tax collectors and sinners. I think he even loved the Scribes and Pharisees with whom he had so many problems. I think they pained him because of their disbelief. He so wanted them to love him like he loved them. Our world needs to be more like Jesus.

How do we stop violence in our world? We need to take personal responsibility for it! Not that I am trying to feed you Catholic guilt – which IS helpful at times. Like it or not, you and I ARE responsible for violence in the world. Think about it. If we have a disagreement with a family member or neighbor or even fellow parishioners that has caused us to dislike the person, we are responsible for violence. Every negative comment or piece of gossip uttered from our mouths is an act of violence. Again, if we loved like Jesus, why would we harbor grudges against another?

We need to **CONSTANTLY** be better examples in and to the world. Dare I go to that "slippery slope" of politics? I was so happy when the primary election was over. I was so ready for the negative advertisements to stop. I so wanted a reprieve. Guess what? The very next day negative ads started for the general election. Why? Because Jesus is **NOT** the center of our lives. It is as if it's OK to disparage someone else to make me look good. It only adds to the violence of our world.

You have to believe that I say this with a mirror before MY face. I have to look at myself honestly saying, "What are you doing that causes violence?" I am guilty of causing violence in the world. I need to be a better example of Jesus in the world. I am sorry for my bad example. Pray God that I become more like Jesus, as I pray that you do too.

**Patriotic Rosary**



**BOX**

Is it worth the risk to keep something in our lives that separates us from God? With that in mind, we can decide what in our lives we should think about getting rid of and make ourselves as ready as we can to meet him when he calls.

**Diocesan Choir Auditions**




