

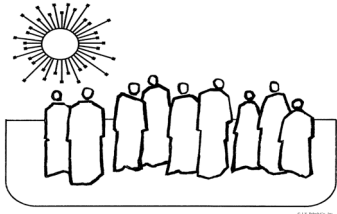

will be touring the church on Saturday, November 7th at 2:45 PM. Young musicians associated with Carnegie Mellon University will perform a work they composed inspired by our stained glass windows. All are welcome.



This Sunday is the first day of November, the month when the Church remembers the dead. We begin, rightly, by acknowledging those men and women who lived exemplary lives of faith and who we believe are with God in heaven. This happens on the Solemnity of All Saints, our parish's patron feast, which is always celebrated on November 1<sup>st</sup> (conveniently on a Sunday this year). The liturgy for All Saints is celebrated with great solemnity and joy, and the hymn "For All the Saints" is almost always sung. The very next day, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, is All Souls' Day, a day in which we remember and pray for the souls of everyone who has passed away, especially those in purgatory. The liturgy on All Souls day is of a more penitential character, and is celebrated similarly to the funeral Mass. The Gloria is not sung, the Creed is not recited, and the propers (the prayers and readings of the day) are from the Requiem Mass (Mass for the Dead). Catholic parishes continue to remember the dead throughout the month, though customs vary regionally and by parish. We should follow the example of the Church, and keep the souls of those who have passed in our thoughts and prayers this month. Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them!
