This is showcased in our four core values, namely:


Prayer: Dependence on God and Communicating with God.

This past week also saw us welcome the Pittsburgh History and Landmarks Foundation for a tour. There will be more details about that in the future, due to bulletin deadlines.

Today marks the second time Bishop Zubik has held an Authorization and Commissioning for Lay Ecclesial Ministers, or LEMs as they are called. Who are these folks? They are people who are credentialed in particular areas and are employed for ministry in a parish. The Diocese speaks of eleven different ministries. They are as follows: Elementary and Secondary Principals, Directors/Coordinators of Religious Education, Directors of Music Ministries, Business Managers, Pastoral Associates, Social Ministers, Youth Ministers, Catholic Campus Ministers, and Health Care Ministers. We will need to work on having Tom Rishel and Bernadette Calvino attain this status. While not yet LEMs, they were able to attend a recent Vicariate District meeting of their peers in ministry. Ask them about it.

This Wednesday marks the anniversary of our Prayer Group. Mass will be celebrated by yours truly at 7:30. As with our organizations, they too could use some more members. And who couldn't use more time for prayer??? They meet every Wednesday.

Thursday evening also sees our Baptismal Preparation Class taking place. If you are pregnant or have a child that needs baptized, this is a course for you! Call the rectory to sign-up.
