Prayer: Dependence on God and Communicating with God.

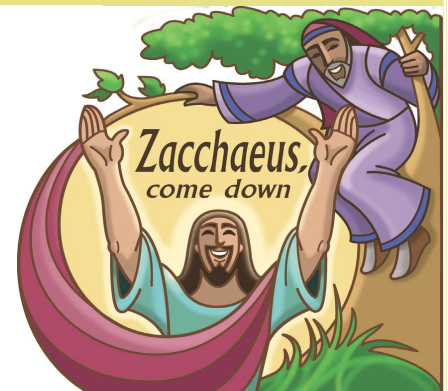
Ministry: Having knowledge of the faith and putting it into practice.

From the Desk of the Administrator

Let's take some time this week to talk about the *On Mission for the Church Alive!* Planning Process. Please, please, PLEASE, did I say PLEASE?, if you did not take the time to attend one of the consultations, take some time to offer your feedback. And even if you DID make one of the consultations, A LOT of information was given. Therefore, it might be helpful to review it all.

For the computer literate, I offer the following. Visit <http://onmissionchurchalive.org/vicariate-4-parish-models/>. First, watch the video of Bishop Zubik introducing the process. If you scroll down that page, you will see Vicariate 4, District 6 – All Saints Parish. Using your mouse, select the “click here” button. It redirects you to another page. There, watch the video that is directly related to our vicariate and district. At the bottom of the page begins the questionnaire that was part of the consultation. It asks if you did or didn't attend a session and then all the subsequent questions. There are 40 questions in total.

If you are NOT computer literate, there are handouts that will be made available. It consists of three items: a Frequently Asked Question sheet, information about the process, and the feedback form. We will make these available NEXT weekend for your use. (Let this week serve as an introduction to that.) The feedback sheets can be brought back to the parish. The box will be under the cross to remind you to PRAY for the process. I will assure they make their way to the proper office to add to the feedback already solicited.

With all that said, let me share OUR models with you. They are as follows:

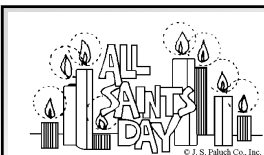

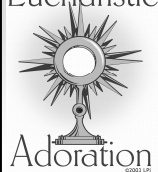


This coming Tuesday, November 1st, we celebrate our parish Feast Day—**ALL SAINTS DAY**.

With the coming of November, we enter a month where the Church focuses on the faithful departed and the second coming of Christ at

the end of time. We rightfully begin that month by honoring the saints on All Saints' Day, our parish's patron feast. Our founder, Father Adolph Keller, placed All Saints under the patronage of all the saints, stating, "we will need all the help that we can get." The important thing to remember about All Saints' Day is that it is not just about the saints we recite often and know, but all those who have died and reached their promised place in the kingdom of heaven. We look to them for their example, and ask for their help in living rightly and faithfully so that we too may one day join them. It is not just our parish as a whole, but each one of us who look to all of the saints for "all the help we can get!" "For All the Saints" is a staple hymn of All Saints' Day.

All Saints' Day is followed by All Souls' Day on November 2nd, where we pray for all the faithful departed, especially those souls that remain in purgatory. Our prayer is that they too may quickly join the ranks of the saints in heaven. All Souls' Day should not be the only day we pray for the souls of the faithful departed, but rather a reminder that they need our prayers each and every day!

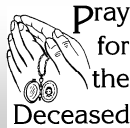
